WILL OF JOHN BEAM

'South Carolina - - - - - -

In the name of God Amen - - - -

I John Beam Sr. of Chester District in the state aforesaid, being weak of body though sound of mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following, that is to say — — First, it is my will that all of my just debts be paid by my executors — — — — —

Secondly, it is my will and desire that the whole of my estate, both real and personal, of whatever kind the same may be, after my decease and the payment of my just debts, be divided into seven equal parts or shares, that is one part or share to each of my children, that is John Beam Jr., Ezekiel Beam, Jesse Beam & Turner Beam, my sons — Sarah Die, Ann Widener & Margaret and that if either of the aforesaid children should die before they come of full age, then shares of said estate be equally divided amongst the survivors disannuling all former wills by me heretofore made declaring this to be my last —— In testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal in presence of us —— December 13th 1819
