ALEXANDRIA, VA. - Col. John Brown Bell, 89, died March 5, 1998.

Sevices were held Tuesday, March 17, 1998 at Fairlington United Methodist Church in Alexandria, Va. Burial followed with full military honors in Arlington National Cemetery March 18, 1998.

Born in Blackstock, July 7, 1908, he was the son of the late Robert McMaster Bell and Anna Carson Bell. Col. Bell served as an Air Force Pilot in World War II in the European Theater and during the Korean War. He completed his service career at the Pentagon.
