Acknowledgments

This compilation is based largely on an account of the family dictated in 1871 by David, son of Charles and Margaret (Reynolds) Montgomery, to E. K. Fulton; on material furnished me by Dr. Charles C. Carroll, a grandson of James and Martha E. (Fuller) Bell, who in turn acknowledged receipt of information from the late Claude M. Maxwell of Starkville, Miss. and New York City; and on personal research in the Federal Census records, court records of Oktibbeha County, Mississippi and other sources.

I. Charles Montgomery m. Margaret Reynolds

This Montgomery family lived in Londonderry, usually called Derry, in the county of Londonderry, Ireland, which is one of the four counties of North Ireland still known as Ulster. When these Montgomery brothers and sisters left their home in 1773 to come to America that part of Ireland was largely settled by Protestants from Scotland.

There were four brothers and four sisters in this family, seven of whom came together in 1773. One sister, Martha, followed them in 1775, coming to Wilmington, N. C. and making the trip to South Carolina where she joined the others. On the ship with these seven brothers and sisters were members of a Bell family and a Reynolds family. Perhaps all were from Derry and well known to each other. At any rate, there were several marriages among these young people. The Montgomery brothers and sisters were as follows:

James, David and Hugh all married and spent the rest of their lives in South

Carolina. We have no knowledge of their descendants. This record is concerned only with Charles and his sister Margaret, who married William Bell and had twelve children- four of whom married their first cousins, children of Charles Montgomery. Of this first generation in America, we have:

This is Charles Montgomery, Revolutionary soldier, and father of the Montgomery brothers and sisters who came to Oktibbeha County, Miss. This abstract does not include the son, Hugh Montgomery, who was living-- possibly an error in copying. A certified copy of the will would be of interest.

Hugh and David of these wills could have been two of the four Montgomery brothers who came in 1773. Note that David (who evidently did not marry) names four sisters. Jane (or Jean) must have been one of the older sisters and married to ___ Rice. Margaret and Martha were probably born in the 1790's and still single in 1808. Our records gives the other sister as Nancy, while this will calls her Elizabeth. Further study indicates that this David was son of Hugh Montgomery who wrote will 10 March 1804. No doubt he was a brother of Charles.

The South Carolina Gazette: 10-1-1772
Last Sunday upwards of 200 Irish Settlers arrived here in the scow JAMES & MARY. Capt. Workman from Laren. Some other vessels with great numbers on board were soon to follow them.

The testator of this will was the ancestor of the two Montgomery sons-in-law named therein; also of descendants of John & Nancy (Montgomery) Thompson, and probably those of James & Mary (Glenn) Bell-- all of whom lived in Oktibbeha County, Miss. His widow, Elizabeth Thompson, came to the county where she died at the age of ninety.
