Item I will & bequeath to my Sister Jenat Blair twenty pounds Strl. & two Gowns one bright Calico & And one Striped & one white peticoat & two handkerchiefs one Single & one Double one-
McDow Item I will & bequeath to my Sister Elisabeth forty pounds Strl. & the Remainder of all my apparell & two Beds & furniture-----Item I will that if my Estate Doth Not amount to the Sum of the above three Sisters Shares it be Reducted Equally from each three Shares & likewise if it amounts to more than the above three Sums that it be Divided Equally amongst the above three Sisters-----

I ordain & appoint Thomas McDow & Thomas Dunlap to be the Lawfull Executors of this my Last will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this 18th Day of December & the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Fifty five 1755 Signed & acknowledged in presence of us
