He was discharged from the service at Greensboro, N.C. on the 26 day of April 1865, and was at that time a member of Company K Regiment of 1st S.C. Battalion of 1st S.C. Captain A.P. Brown. I was born June day of 1849. I was married to him 8 day of Sept 1877. My husband did not desert the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 6th day of Dec 1890. My income from all sources does not exceed \$ 50.00. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$ 50.00. I am 70 years of age. I reside at Blair in Fairfield County, S. C., and have lived there since the 1849 day of 1849.

I have been on the pension roll of South Carolina in Class C #4. I am not on the Pension roll of any other State, nor of the United States.
