Oklahoma City University, worth over \$14,000, and a full-tuition scholarship to the Art Institute, worth \$11,000.

The South Carolina National Teen-Ager Scholarship Program will be awarding over \$100,000 in scholarships to such universities as Columbia College, Southern Wesleyan, Spartanburg Methodist, Johnson and Wales, Coastal Carolina and North Greenville College. Also, every participant will receive a \$200 scholarship to the John Robert Powers School of Modeling.
