Here is Richard married to Rose and the family profile from 1880, Twp 5, Fairfield Co. Twp 5 is where the Boulware Big House was located starting in the 1700s- Named: Eagle House. Your list is consistant with the names you emailed. Richard's birth date is off but do your checks and balance by the names. You may want to disregard the first family I sent because Richard can't be in two places at once in 1880. And the Richard born to Noah is only 14 and too young to marry. However, based on the 1866 date you gave, they may be related. Good Luck in your analysis. You may have two generations so far. There are many Boulwares listed in Fairfield County, almost in every township, but few Richards and a Rosa match. You can copy all the original info from the Archives or end up paying your Historical Society for a copy of Benjamine F. Boulware's Will, where you'll see who was willed to whom before 1865. If the family is mulatto, then you'll want to follow the Boulware maste r's bloodline...

You have to pay strict attention to the Enumeration Number 71, and page number 132.4000 as house wholes were counted in the neighborhood one behind the other on the Census. Remember, if the master did not have his main home located in Winnsboro, then most likely, he was not far away from the slaves.
