

Muscoe Boulware, 1758-1825 was a soldier of the Revolution. In state VA. State Library in List of Rev. Soldiers of VA. Auditor's Account XXVII-118. He and his wife Nancy are now buried within the Boulware Walls (Restored) Ten miles from Winnsboro, S. C. on the Flint Hill is its location. "This old cemetery is of unusual extent for a family burying ground, and its wall of such massive construction that trees of considerable size are growing from the top of the walls which are still in good state of preservation.
