I need to know the descendants of a John BOYDE identified as selling land to John MOBBERLEY in 1697 (Prince George Co., MD Land Records: VOL. 1/1692/1702). I also need to know the ancestors of John MOBBERLEY. To date, this is the information I have on the above:

BOYDE (indicates in body of transaction that his wife is Mary BOYDE) (Also designates "John BOYDE of the county of Prince Georges in the province of Maryland" and "John MOBBERLY of the county of Ann Arundel in the province of Maryland". Land transacted was Ample Grange in P. G.)

* On 5/1or7/1807, a Richard NEELY sold 100 acres of land on McGraw's Creek, branch of Little River, Fairfield Co., SC to John BOYD (land orig. granted to Richard Neely, Sr. 4-25-1765 & surveyed 7-1-1763) (Richard Neely was

married to Nancy Ann MOBLEY). CLEMENT MOBLEY and ALEXANDER MOBLEY are also referenced as having sold 100 acres of land "on waters of Little River, granted on May 8, 1771 to Richard Neely, Sr." to John BOYD (Is this BOYD the father or brother of David BOYD, b. 1803 ?)

- * Is there any relation between the JOHN BOYDE in the first transaction of 1697 in Prince Georges Co., MD and the John BOYD in the second transaction of 1807 in Fairfield, Co., SC ?
- * Is David BOYD, b. 1803, Fairfield Co.(I believe), SC related to either John BOYDE in MD or John BOYD in Fairfield Co., SC ?
