My grandmother Carrie Rebecca Boyd was born around May 2, 1926 in South Carolina. Her parents names were Carrie Mack and Richard Boyd. The family is listed living in the 1940 census records of Fairfield, Township 10, South Carolina ED No. 20-15 Sheet 8B. James D. Taylor was born around 1923 in South Carolina his parents names were Mary Taylor and Lonnie Ross. James D. Taylor was living with his widowed grandmother, Hanna aunt and siblings in the 1940 census records of Fairfield county, township 9 in South Carolina. ED no 20-14 Sheet 5B. Family members says that Carrie Rebecca Boyd married James D Taylor when she was a young girl around 1940-1942. They had 7 children together. James D acquired land from his grand father Simon Taylor. Simon Taylor is list in the 1930 census records of Fairfield county township 9 with his family on the farm he owned. ED no. 20-16 Sheet 2B. It would mean so much in so many ways if you can see if my grandparents were married and if my great grandfather owned land in Fairfield. Looking forward to hearing from you.

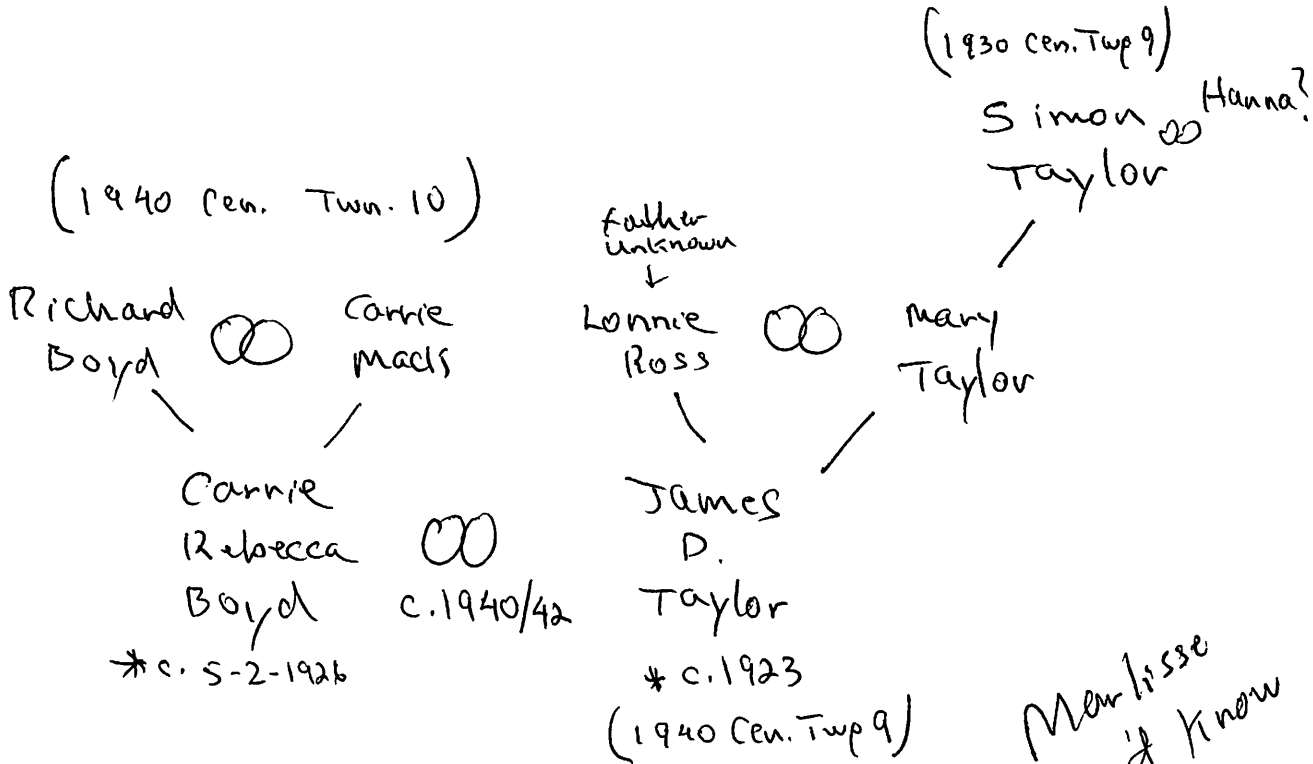
