

Winnsboro man dies in single vehicle wreck

WINNSBORO — The S.C. Highway Patrol reported a wreck around 10:20 p.m. June 28 on S.C. 213 just north of Jenkinsville, where one man was ejected and died at the scene.

According to the SCHP, a 1997 Ford van was being driven by a 60-year-old man from Winnsboro.

The second occupant, Jackie Boyd,

died after being ejected from the vehicle. Corp. Bill Rhyne said Boyd was not wearing a seat belt. The Fairfield County Coroner reported the cause of death as a multi-trauma.

The driver was also not wearing his seat belt and was trapped in the vehicle. He was transported to Richland Memorial Hospital for his injuries by EMS.

The wreck remains under investigation by the S.C. Highway Patrol.
