

THE BRICE LINE

The three original brices were born in Ballymena, County of Antrim Ireland. They came to this country about 1790. Their names are as follows:

- (Sons of William Brice and Jane McClure of County Antrim)
1. William Brice, Sr., Born 1760, died April 29th. 1849 (He is our Great Grand-father)
 2. John Brice, Died Oct. 20th. 1863
 3. James Brice

These three must have been grown men when they came to this country. We shall now take up their children:

1. WILLIAM BRICE:

William Brice was our great grand father, he being the father of Grace Jane Brice Douglas, the mother of our father, the mother of Rev. James Douglas, Alexander Brown Douglas and Charlie Douglas. William Brice was born in Ballymena, Antrim County, Ireland in 1760 and died in this country on April 29th. 1849. at the age of 89 years. He came to this country about 1790. We cannot say positively whom he married but think her name was Elizabeth Phillips. She died June 27th. 1838. The names of their children are as follows:

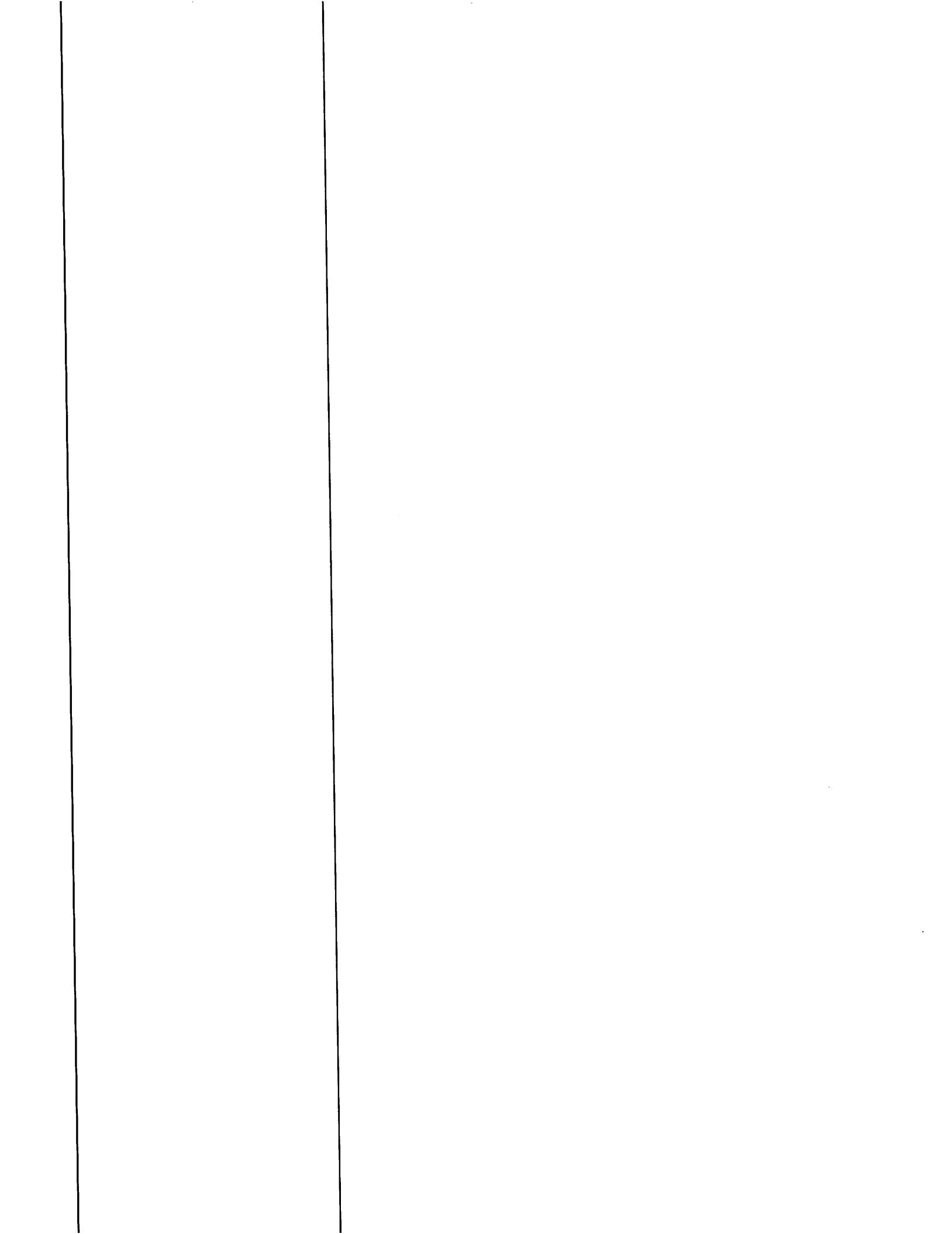

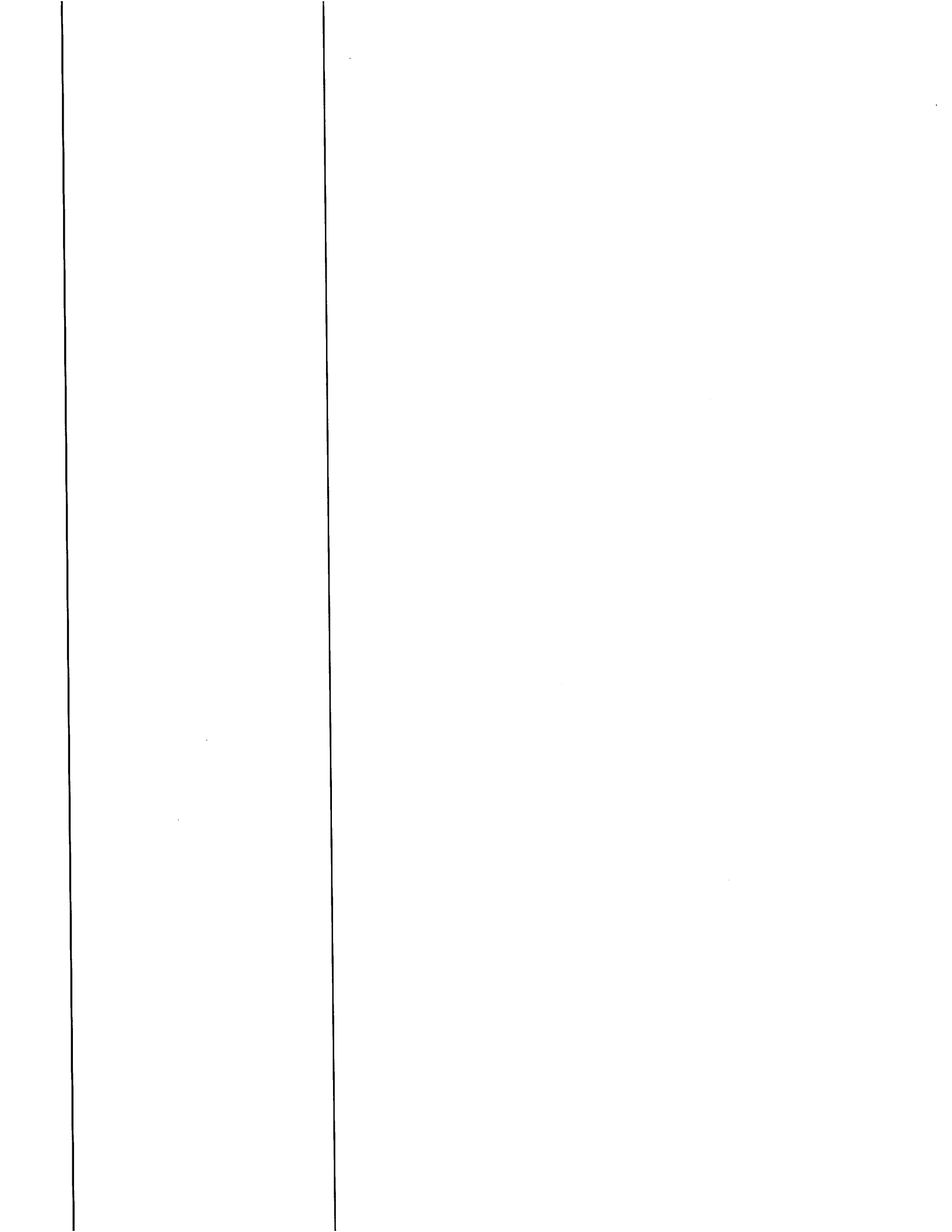
A. James C. Brice.

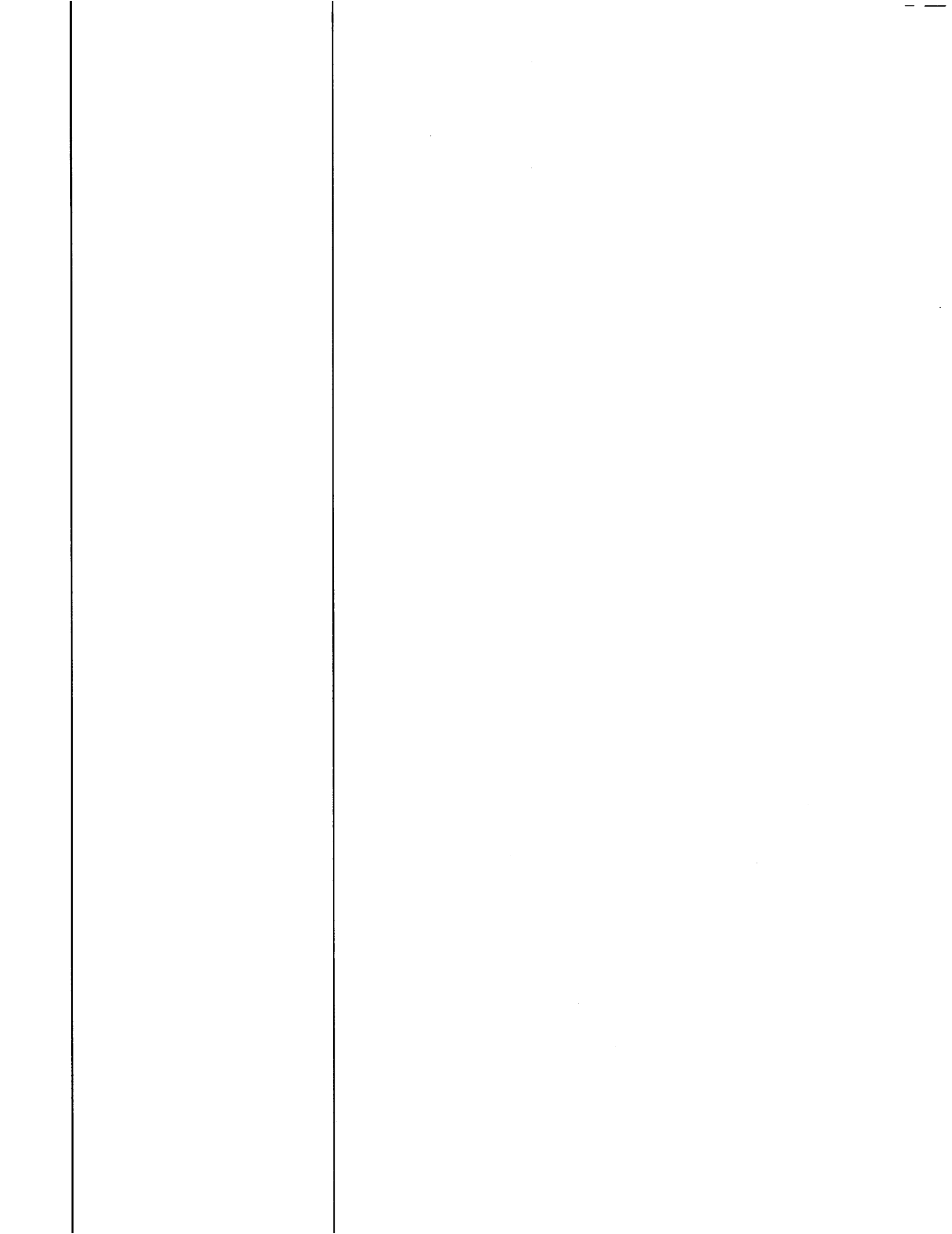
C. Jinet Brice Brice.

Jinet Brice was born Spet. 14th, 1796 and died July 19th. 1869. She married Robert Brice her first cousin, he was the son of James Brice. They had no children. They were married in old age, probably both were over sixty years old when they married. It is said that when they got ready to get married, they got in a buggy and rode to the preacher's house without letting him know what they were coming for, and the preacher not suspecting anything sat in the parlor and talked to them about the usual subjects of conversation, weather, crops, etc. till finally Robert Brice said to his prospective bride, "Well, Jane, we had better get the preacher to do what we came to have done" and thereupon the preacher proceeded to make them husband and wife.

Robert Brice was born July 5th. 1809 and died in 1866. He Never married.

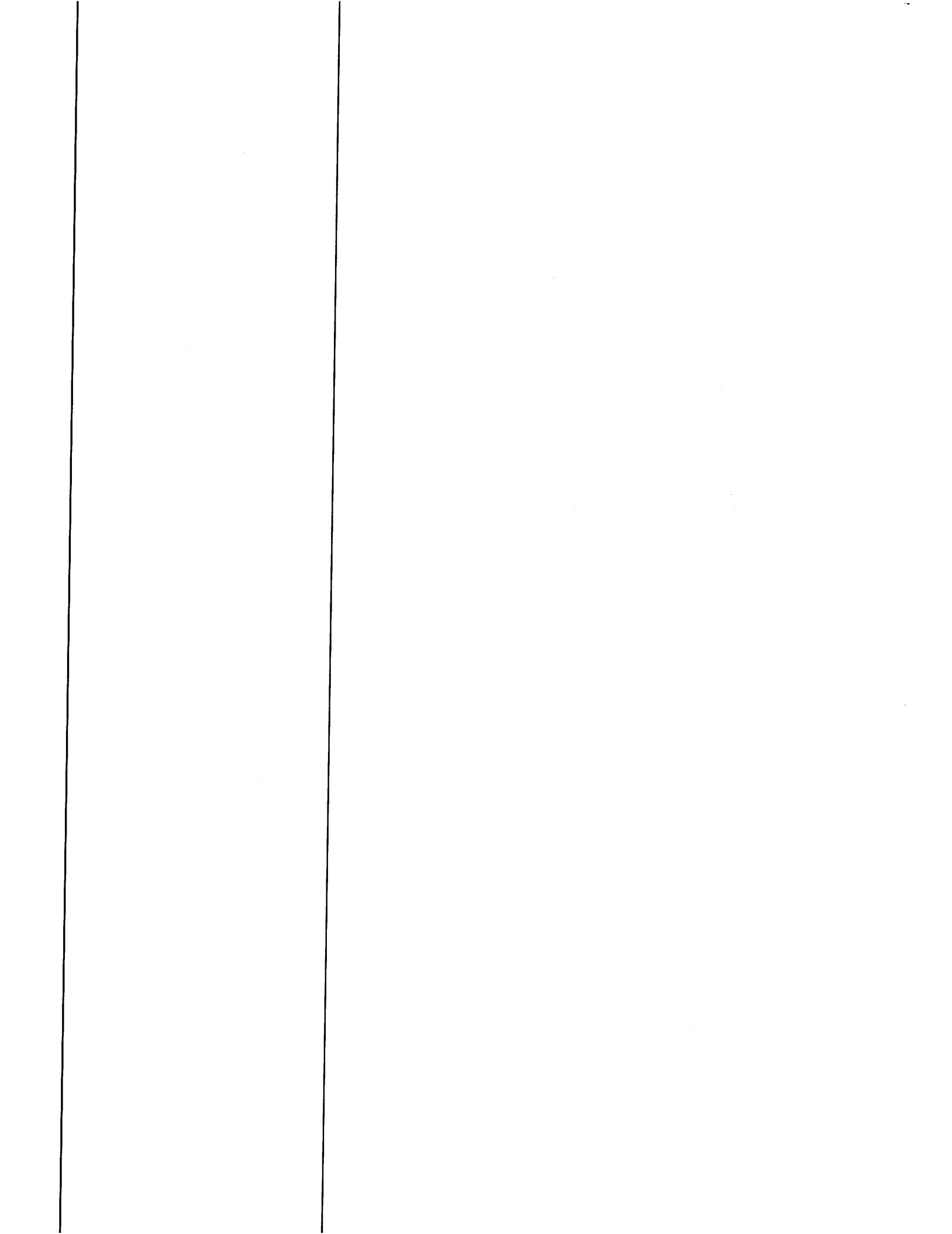

They did not like to be called Irish or have their name spelled with the double "S" as that implied to them that they were Irish Catholics, ~~while they were actually of the Scotch Presbyterian~~.
