Wade Brice who enlisted in Company H. 6<sup>th</sup> Regiment of 11<sup>th</sup> Battalion of Means Captain on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1864 and served in that command until the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1862. He was discharged from the service at Chester S.C. on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April 1865, and was at that time a member of Company H. 2<sup>nd</sup> Regiment of Cavalry Battalion of Measles Captain. I was born 8<sup>th</sup> day of Nov 1837. I was married to him 26<sup>th</sup> day of Feb 1863. My husband did not desert the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 1870. My income from all sources does not exceed \$750.00. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$6000.00. I am 82 years of age. I reside at Trueman in Fairfield County, S. C., and have lived there since the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February 1877. I have been on the pension roll of South Carolina in Class C. No. 4. I am not on the Pension roll of any other State, nor of the United States.
