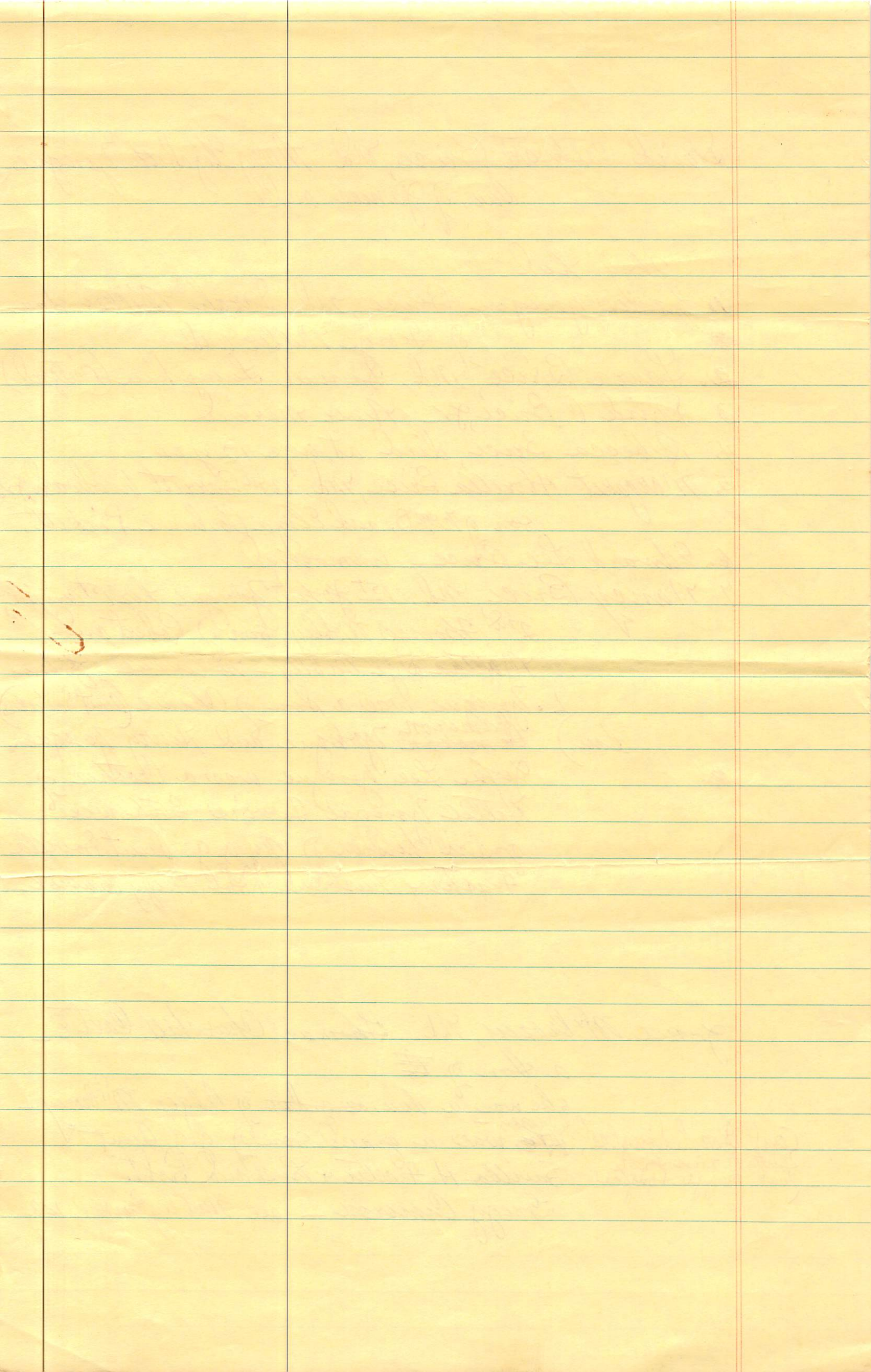

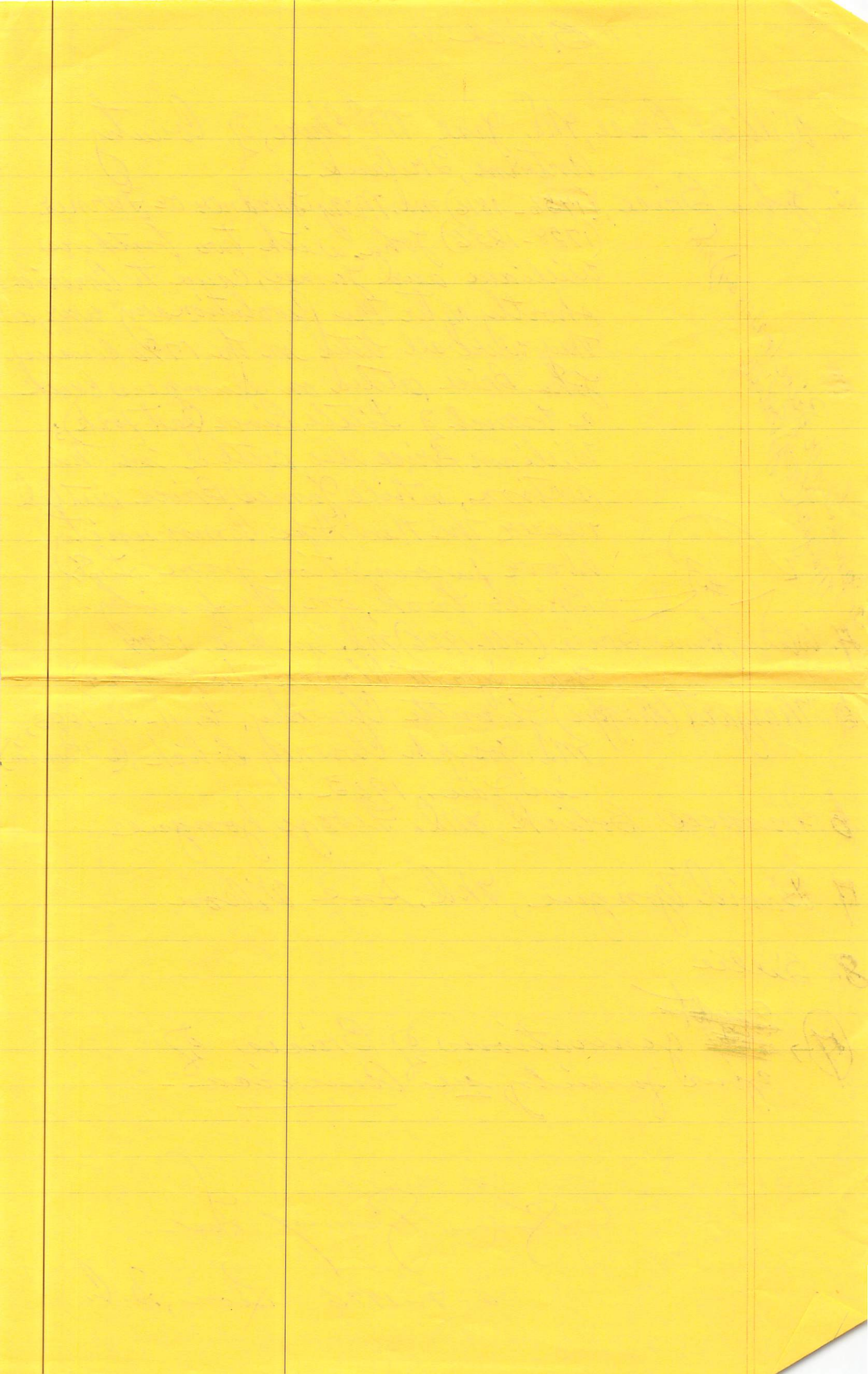
1. William Brice, Md. Jane McClure, of County Antrim, Ireland -
