He was apparently improving until a few days ago when taken ill again and the end came this morning.

Mr. Bryce served with Co. "B", Gill's battalion, South Carolina Reserves.

The body was taken to Winnsboro. Services will be held Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock at the family burial ground in Fairfield county.

Mr. Bryce is survived by three brothers, J.W., C.R. and T.R. Bryce, all of Fairfield county.
