According to records, Lt. Brice's division, the 106th Infantry, arrived in England on November 17, 1944, trained briefly there, then moved to France on December 6, 1944. This division relieved the 2d Infantry Division in the Schnee Eifel on December 11th. The Von Rundstedt attack, the beginning of the Ardennes Offensive, was thrown in force at the 106th Division on December 16, 1944. This division suffered 564 killed in action, 1,246 wounded and 7,001 missing in action. The telegram sent to the Brice family states that Lt. Brice was reported as Missing in Action on this date.
