this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of

*Two Pounds two Shillings and ten Pence  
and ten Pence Half Penny for 30 Days Duty  
done in the Militia in 1782 as per Account  
Vouched*

the said *Francis Bryant*  
his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns will be entitled to receive from  
this Office the Sum of *Three Shillings*

on the Demand *of*  
one Year's Interest on the Principal Sum of *Two Pounds two  
Shillings and ten Pence half Penny*  
and the like Interest Annually

The said *Francis Bryant* — his Executors, Ad-  
ministrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid,  
if demanded, the principal Sum of *Two Pounds two Shillings  
and ten Pence half Penny*

on the *Twenty fourth of January 1787*  
And the said *Francis Bryant*  
his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at  
any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered  
by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be re-  
ceived in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner abovementioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the afore said ACT.
