Shillings and two Pence
and the like Interest Annually

The said Sarah Bryant her Executors, Ad-
ministrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid,
if demanded, the principal Sum of Three Pounds Four
Shillings and two Pence
on the Twenty Fourth of January 1707
And the said Sarah Bryant her
Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at
any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered
by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be re-
ceived in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner above men-
tioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of
the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT
