After the decease of Sarah Hardage Know all men by these presents that I William Briant and Mathew McBright of the County of Fairfield and common wealth of South Carolina have of our own free will and accord doth remise release and set free or negro woman namely agg and by these presents doth acquit all claim or claims from us or our heirs &c and ad^m and by these presents doth remise release and forever quit claim unto D negro agg of the County and state aforesaid now if we or our heirs &c or our assigns should claim or pretend to have any claim to the said negro agg under any pretence whatsoever then this our obligation shall oblige us or our heirs to pay or cause to be paid unto the said negro agg or her attorney at law the just and full sum of three hundred pounds sterling in Spanish -

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if either of the above named person or persons shall or may claim the D agg under any pretence whatsoever that the above obligation shall stand in full force and Virtue according to law otherwise to remain as it stands States In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this second day of December 1794
