Dr. Robert (Cornell) practice 1847-1887 - 40
Dr. John, Sr. (MUSC) " 1887-1929 42
Dr. John, Jr. (Wash. U) " 1926-1986 60

139 continuous years

John, Sr., had office back of O'Bear's Drug Store

He later bought the Johnson House

When he retired family lived in Wolfe House

Robert was disabled - did not take part in Civil War

Was the only "doctor" left in Winns.

John, Sr. practiced with Dr. Ralph Hanahan and Spencer
McCants in the early days.

His first car was an Olds (yr.?)

John, Jr. built his office "hosp." in 1935

Del. babies both at home and in hosp. here

Once delivered a woman near Blair who was bleeding etc.

He and nurse drove to home...bad storm...had to stay

2 nights. Transfused his own blood - had been

approved as doner.
