Secondly I give, and bequeath unto my son Robert Buchanan Two Negroes to Wit. Sarah and her infant child "in trust however" for the use and Lamifit of John A Stewart and his beirs. Thirdly. I give and bequeath unto my said son Robert Buchanen Two other negroes to wit. Adam and Nancy, "in trust"however for my son Calvin Buchanan Fourthly I give and bequeath unto the said Robert Buchanan, Two other negroes to wit. Evens and her child Jim in trust however for the use and benefit of my son James S. Stewart. and his heirs. It is further my will and desire that my son Robert Suchanan should, collect all the money now due se, and that he shall retain for his own use, and as his com the sum of four hundred dollars and that he shall pay over to my son James S. Stewart. out of the remainder of said money, the sum of Five hundred dollars, the ballance he is directed to pay over to my son John A. Stewart. To my Daughter Elisa, the wife of J Makery Elliott I have already given, a negro girl nemed Amef which I entend for her portion of my Estate, - The Bequest above made to my eon Calvin Buchanan, so far as one of the negroes is consermed, to wit, the negro girl Nancy, I do hereby revoke, and it is my will and desire, and I do bequeath the said magro girl Mancy to my grand daughter, Elizabeth Wilson Ellists to her and her heirs forever, And it is my further wish that all the remaining portion of my effects shall be divided, emong my children by my Executors hereinafter named in such a marmor as to them shall seem meet. testimony whereof I have herento set my hand and seal ordaining end declaring this to be my last will and testament. this the let day of January 1846
