He was discharged from the service at Charleston on the day of 1861, and was at that time a member of Company 16 Regiment of 6th Infantry Battalion of Captain J. G. Geiger. I was born 19 day of Sept 1846. I was married to him 25 day of Dec 1863. My husband did not desert the service of the Confederate States nor of this State. My husband died on the 13 day of July, 1908. My income from all sources does not exceed \$100.00. The valuation of all my property does not exceed \$100.00.

I am 73 years of age. I reside at Academy Street in Hanfield, County, S. C., and have lived there since the day of June 1890.

I have been on the pension roll of South Carolina in Class 1. I am not on the Pension roll of any other State, nor of the United States.
