

Hoy Chalmers Bundrick Sr.

RIDGEWAY - Hoy Chalmers Bundrick Sr., 73, died Sunday, March 23, 1997 at Richland Memorial Hospital. 3/27/97

Services were held March 24, 1997 at Westside First Church of God. Burial followed in Greenlawn Memorial Park.

Born in Chapin, he was the son of the late Arthur Belton Bundrick and Bertha Stone Bundrick.

He was a World War II Army veteran, and received medals for five major campaigns and the Bronze Star, a citation for bravery in action. He owned and operated Bundrick's 66 Service Station on Monticello Road for over 25 years. He taught Men's Sunday School Class and Adult Bible Study at First Church of God on Covenant Road for over 35 years, and later was assistant Sunday School Teacher of the Adult Class at Westside First Church of God, he was a member, on the Board of Trustees, and active with the Men's Brotherhood.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy Wooten Bundrick of Ridgeway; one son, Hoy C. Bundrick Jr., of Columbia; one daughter, Linda Bundrick Brown and son-in-law, Tom Brown of West Columbia; one sister, Gladys Bickley of West Columbia; and three grandchildren.
