This book is the result of many years of research. Many family members have contributed to the information recorded in this work, which contains most descendants of William and Agnes Hadden Caldwell, who settled along the Tyger River in the late 1700's after they came to Charleston from Ireland. Richard Fowler, who has written other genealogies, has assisted in the writing and production of this book. His books on Laurens and Upstate South Carolina also contain some of the members of this family.

There are almost 2700 persons recorded in the book, and about 1435 direct descendants. There is a historical section, which discusses the history of the region, the Caldwell name and original members and provides interesting stories and information on several of the illustrious members of this family. The historical section also contains information on landmarks around Nazareth Church and some of its history. The book has about 260 pages with a handy index.

There are two separate genealogical chapters. The first provides an **OUTLINE** of all the descendants of William Caldwell, for quick reference. The second genealogy is more complete, as it contains notes, marriage information, children, Revolutionary and Civil War data, and cemetery locations,

In the Appendix are 15 ancestral charts of principal spouses in this family so that the reader can quickly trace the ancestry on both sides. Appendix II contains copies of the significant legal documents Carroll has collected, such as wills, service records and land grants. The final Appendix contains a number of family photographs taken and preserved for more than 100 years. A place is made for the book owner to record his own family data.

This book has a durable hard cover with gold lettering. It will make an ideal gift or serve as a valuable addition to every family's bookcase.

Family genealogy

CALDWELL FAMILY

1. John Caldwell: b. March 19, 1726/27 in county Antrim, Ireland
m. Mary Elizabeth Young (b. about 1738 d. 1836). Immigrated from
Belfast, Northern Ireland through the Port of Charles Towne,
South Carolina in 1767 with other Scots-Irish Presbyterians.
Moved to Spartanburg County. Received a land grant from King
George III of England on June 7, 1772 for 250 acres on the Tyger
River. On October 21, 1784 the state of South Carolina granted
him 98 acres on the middle Tyger River. John Caldwell died on
July 19, 1807 in Spartanburg County, SC, USA and is buried near
Nazareth Presbyterian Church.

2. Andrew Caldwell b. 1777/79? d. September 4, 1854. In 1804 m.
Rosannah Hughes (b. 1786/91? d. October 18, 1843/48?). He deeded
part of his Caldwell land to the Nazareth church congregation.

3. John Young Caldwell b. January 15, 1806 d. December 24, 1881.
On December 29, 1831 m. Eliza Jane Brown (b. April 1, 1808
d. August 26, 1888).

4. Andrew Jackson Caldwell b. June 7, 1834 d. September 11, 1904.
On December 18, 1879 m. Isabella Wilhelmina Simmons (b. August 8,
1859 d. October 18, 1941). Both are buried in Nazareth
Presbyterian Church cemetery, Spartanburg, SC.

5.3. "infant son of A.J. & I. W. Caldwell" b. & d. August 9,
1885 buried in Nazareth cemetery

5.7. Elmer Jerome b. August 2, 1893 d. October 15, 1895
buried in Nazareth cemetery "Asleep in Jesus"

5.9. Lois Wilhelmina b. January 18, 1898 d. May 23, 1906
buried in Nazareth cemetery

NOTES on Andrew Jackson Caldwell: In 1896 he related "A.J.
Caldwell's Travels Through Life" to his daughter, Jessie C.
Toomer. In summary, he was a carpenter and a farmer who as a
young man lived in Mississippi four different times. He served in
the Civil War as Sgt. in Company E, 2nd SC Cavalry, CSA from
1860-1865. He lived in California from 1872-1875 and reportedly
returned with gold sewn into the lining of his coat. He married
in 1879 and settled near Inman. He was on the Board of County
Commissioners in 1889 and 1890 and superintended the building of
the Spartanburg County Court House in 1891. Finally in 1892 they
settled on the old Thomas Prince land located between Campobello
and Gowensville.
