Joseph and Catherine Elder Caldwell came to the hill country of northeast Fairfield from Northern Ireland in 1804 with two children. They had twelve children in all. Eight had families; six of these large families.

This book is their story and the story of their descendents, over 1400 of them. Possibly 95% of all the descendents are listed. Where available, information is given on dates of births, marriages, and deaths; on places where lived or living; and on occupations, military service, special honors, etc.

The story of the family covers a span from a time when sea travel was by slow sailing ship (Joseph's Father was a sea captain) to a time when oceans are crossed in a few hours by jet planes. It covers a span from a time when land travel was all by horseback or horse drawn vehicles over muddy roads to our system of interstate highways. From a time when "a large red cow" sold for \$4.00 to a time when one pound of beef costs as much or more.

Our cousin families stretch from New England to California, from Florida to Alberta, Canada; with some overseas; but most of them live in the Southern States, from Virginia to Texas.

It is not practical to list them all here, but some of the main family names, in addition to the present day Caldwells, are: Kinloch, Doty, Withers, Johnston, Cardwell, Cheatham.
