Winnsboro native Kyle Caldwell was commissioned an ensign in the U.S. Navy in ceremonies on Jan. 1.

Caldwell is the son of James and Lethia Caldwell of Winnsboro. He is a 1990 graduate of Fairfield Central High School.

Caldwell and his wife, Laticia Trevon Caldwell, have two children, Shatara, 9, and Kyle, II, 1.

He is currently assigned to the USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71), homeported in Norfolk, VA.
