


















Life Legacy

Robert C. Caldwell Sr., 98, of Winnsboro passed away on November 23, 2014. Born June 17, 1916, in the Rossville Section of Chester County, he was a Master Mason and a member of the Winnsboro Lions Club. He was the son of James S.H. and Willie McMeekin Caldwell, and was a lifelong member of Ebenezer United Methodist Church.

His working life was in the electric utility sector and he began his career in 1938 with Bridges Construction Company building some of the very first lines for Berkeley Electric Cooperative and then spent two years in North Carolina constructing lines for cooperatives there. He retired from Fairfield Electric Cooperative after 39 years of service where he served as Line Superintendent.

While in North Carolina he met and married Margaret Daniel of Mocksville.
