Jane: THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

I Jane S. Caldwell of Fairfield District In the State aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament in manner & form following, viz.

Item 1. I give and bequeath to my son James Caldwell three negro Slaves, namely a man called Singo, xxx a woman called Lucy xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx. Also one third of my flock of sheep, all blacksmith tools, the cotton gin and wheat thrasher, and half of my stock of cattle, two mules, called Peet and Mike and one horse called Jack, and one bedstead and bed and the usual bed clothes.

Item 2d. I give and devise to my daughter Eliza Caldwell, all the plantation and tract of land whereon I now reside, containing two hundred and forty nine and a half acres situate in the District of Fairfield and State aforesaid, being all the land which was divided off and assigned to me by the commissioners under proceedings in the Court of Equity for partition of the Estate of my husband Robert Caldwell deceased, for and during the term of her natural life, but in cast of her marriage, not to be in any wise subject or liable to the debts, contracts or encumbrances of her husband and at the death of my said daughter, to the heirs of her body who my be then living, share and share alike; and in case my said daughter Eliza shall die without leaving issue of her body living at the time of her death, than said plantation and tract of land is to be equally divided between my three sons, James, William, and Robert, their heirs and assigns in fee simple.

I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Eliza, two negro slaves, namely a woman called Byna and a girl called Peggy, for and during the natural life of my said daughter, but in case of her marriage, not to be in any wise subject or liable the debts contracts or incumbrances of her husband, and at the death of said daughter, I give and bequeath said negro slaves their issue and increase to the heirs of the body of my said daughter who may be living at the time of her death equally to be divided among them, the issue of a deceased child, if any such, to represent the parent, & take the share which the parent would be entitled to if living: but in case my said daughter Eliza shall die without leaving issue of her body living at the time of her death, then I will and direct that said Negroes & their increase be sold, and the proceeds equally divided among all my children, the issue of a deceased child, should there be any such, to take the share which the parent would be entitled to if living, & represent the parents, I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Eliza, my now Buggy and harness, my loom & harness, my cupboard and

silverware, all my kitchen furniture and all my table furniture, my mantle clock, two mules called Bet and Poll, and one third of my sheep.

Item 3d. I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Wylie, wife of Vander A. Wylie, two Negroes, namely, a woman called Carolina and her daughter Martha, (together with their future issue and increase,) for and during the natural life of my said daughter Jane Wylie, but not in any wise to be subject or liable to the debts, contracts or incumbrances of her present, or any future husband, and at the death of said daughter, said negro slaves and their issue and increase, to be equally divided among the heirs of her body who may be then living but in case my said daughter Jane Wylie shall die without leaving issue of her body living at the time of her death, then I will and, direct that said two negro slaves and their issue and increase, be sold and the proceeds be equally divided among all my children, the issue of a deceased child, if any such, to represent the parent, and take the share which the parent would be entitled to if living. I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Jane Wylie one cow, one folding leaf pine tables one short posted bedstead, one bed, 1 pair sheets, corded counterpane, 1 boalster and pair of pillows.

Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my son William Caldwell, a negro boy called Little Sam and, a girl call Mary, also one bedstead and bed & the usual bedclothes, one cow and one stock hog and one a sixth of the sheep.

Item 5th. I give and bequeath to my son Robert Caldwell, a negro man called Joe, and a negro boy called George, also one cot and our bed & the usual bedclothes, one cow, one stock hog, and one sixth of the sheep.

Item 5th. I give and bequeath all my plantation implements to my son James & my daughter Eliza equally to be divided among them.

Item 6th My son James is to have half the crop which shall be made on my plantation this year, the other half of crop I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza and my sons William & Robert, share and share alike. All my corn, wheat, fodder, meat, and other provisions I wish remain on the plantation for he joint and common use of my daughter Eliza and my three sons James, William and Robert.

item 7th All the money an hand at the time of my deceased, I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza and my two sons William and Robert, share and share alike.

Item 8th All the rest of my household furniture not otherwise disposed of, I give to my daughter Eliza.

Item 9th. I give and devise, to my son James Caldwell all my interest and share, as one of the heirs at law of my son Henry S. Caldwell deceased, in the tract of land assigned to said Henry S. and James Caldwell by the court of Equity under proceedings for partition of the Estate of my husband Robert Caldwell deceased.

Item 10th. All the rest residue and remainder of my Estate of every kind and, description whatsoever whether according to xxx xxx the Estate of my husband Robert Caldwell deceased, or from the Estate of my deceased Sons Henry S. Caldwell and Alexander M. Caldwell, I give, devise and bequeath to my daughter Eliza, and my Sons James, William and Robert, share and share alike.

Item 11th. I nominate and appoint my son James Caldwell and my friend, James Simonton, John Brice

of Dumpers Creek and James Johnston executors of this my last will and testament.

Part of the third line of the 1st item was erased before the execution.

Our information is very meager (sic), but we have heard that she was in her usual health until a few days before her death. She was the mother of Mr. Henry C. Grafton and Mrs. B. A. Ragsdale. She was a Caldwell before her marriage, and at the time of her death was about 69 years old.

Recently he and Mrs. Grafton moved to Lawrys to make their home with their nephew.

He is survived by his widow who was Kiss Millie Lyles, and his nephew, Mr. Bynum.

Funeral services for Miss Sallie E. Wylie will be held this afternoon at three o'clock at the late home on Pinckney street, with Rev. A. M. Miss Wylie, who was seventy-nine years of age, died at her home on Pinckney street Thursday morning about nine-thirty o'clock. Her death was not wholly unexpected, as she had been in failing health for some time, and for the past week had been quite ill.

A daughter of the late Samuel A. Wylie and Jane Caldwell Wylie, Miss Wylie was born on November 7, 1855, in the Wellridge section of Chester county. She was educated at the Due West Woman's College and taught for many years in the schools of this county. She was one of the oldest living members of the Sallie Miller Brice Chapter of Esrkin College. She was one of Chester's best known and widely beloved women, who in her younger years took a lively interest in various social and welfare activities. She was a devoted member of the Pleasant Grove Presbyterian church. Always kind, thoughtful, generous and hospitable, and endowed with a keen interest in the welfare of others, she was beloved not only by the members of her family, but by all who came under the gracious influence of her nature.
