Will dated Jan. 8, 1787 in Newberry Dist. Proved Jan. 25, 1787. Exrs: Charles Burton. Wit: Robt. Moore, Charles Thompson. Wife, Jenney Hannah. Dtr. Nancy Chapman. s.l. Charles Burton. Paid Sam Chapman for the land. "Bequeath a calf to little Jean Oiens." Nov. 15, 1808 Paid L. B. Bostick his wife's legacy \$644.86. Dec. 8, Paid Thos. Chapman \$15.50. (Note: The Expend: of Jno. Chapman decd. to Nathan and Benjamin Chapman admnr. in same pack.)

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
