and the like Interest annually.

The said *Giles Chapman* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Three Pounds*

on the *Twenty first of April 1788*

And the said *Giles Chapman* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for Special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforefaid ACT.
