





SCHOON, JOHN BALIS 5:261 50 Acres Jan 29, 1750 Eleazer Creek of Cannon's Creek Later owned by William Ancrum, who sold land to George Kinard, 8 Feb 1800 (Nby Deed Book K, p. 353). SCHRADIN, MARGARET 12:137 Dec 3, 1753 50 Acres Wateree Creek "On Elizabeth" J.C. 21(1). SCHROEDER, FREDERICK 12:137 200 Acres Nov 22, 1753 Fork of Broad and Saluda Rivers "On Edinburgh, wife and 2 children: Dorothy 8, Frederick 5". J.C. 21(1). Referred to as land of Jacob Son on Plat of Catherine Setzler in 1767. (19:404), also in 1772, on plat of Michael Earlybush (14:523).
