Chandler, Joseph Benson, Sr. Co. G, CPT, from Sumter Dst. Age 19 when entered the SC Arsenal at Columbia 1/48 (at this time the Columbia and Charleston Arsenals were part of the Citadel). Trn. to the Citadel in Charleston on 1/1/49, Graduated seventh in a class of twenty-six November 1851. Named 1st LT in 1851. Merchant in Kansas 1857. Rtn. to Williamsburg District and married Martha Troy Flagler of Cedar Swamp Community. School teacher and merchant at Cedar Swamp, SC in 1860. Organized Williamsburg Rifles and named CPT at age 33. Williamsburg Rifles formed at Indiantown Presbyterian Ch. in Williamsburg Dst. 9/16/61 and became Co. G of the 15th RGT SC INF. Prs. for duty at Lightwood Knot Springs 10/14/61. Paid 11/13/61. Resigned 12/1/61. Served as MAJ in SC

Militia during the war. Gave the land for Cedar Swamp Methodist Ch. in 1878. Served as member of the State House of Representatives from Williamsburg 1880 and 1886. D. 1897. Bur. Cedar Swamp Methodist Ch. Cem. near Kingstree, SC. Son of Daniel Dial Chandler and Elizabeth Winn. CSR, ACM, FR, CR, HWC, WC

Sent to City Point, VA 4/14/65. Signed Oath of Allegiance to the U.S. at Pt. Lookout, MD 6/24/65. Light complexion, light hair, gray eyes, 5' 7". CSR, SCDAH, TLE, KPOW

CSR, OWCR, HW, WC

Extra duty as orderly for LT COL Gist 9 & 10, 1863. Extra duty as Orderly to Regimental HQ 11 & 12, 1863. Extra duty Orderly for CPT Lewie Commanding RGT 1 & 2, 1864. Extra duty Orderly at Regimental HQ 3 & 4, 1864. Prs. for duty 5 & 6, 1864. Trn. to Co. A Hampton Legion 12/3/64. CSR
