

## 1920 RICHLAND COUNTY CENSUS

School District #4, (p. 201) Enumerated 2 Jan. 1920 by Otis Chewning

We will list Street address, family number, name of head of household, relationship to head of household, age; where born (other than SC) and some occupations. This census is difficult to read on microfilm, most of the time the census taker wrote "cotton mill" for occupation. School District #4 covered lots of area that we would not consider Olympia; such as, Maple Street, Millwood Ave, Moores Ave, lower Sumter Street, etc. For this reason we have chosen to list the family numbers.
