This census is difficult to read on microfilm, most of the time the census taker wrote "cotton mill" for occupation. School District #4 covered lots of area that we would not consider Olympia; such as, Maple Street, Millwood Ave, Moores Ave, lower Sumter Street, etc. For this reason we have chosen to list the family numbers.
