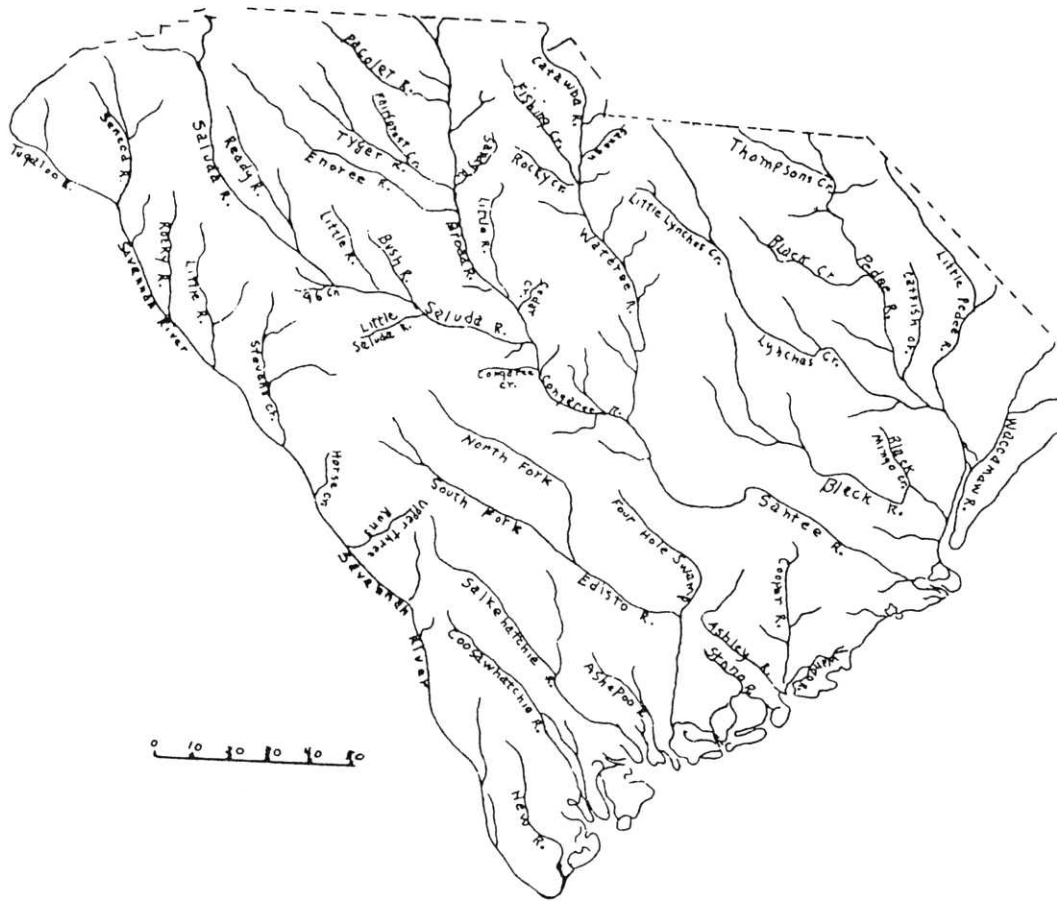

SOUTH CAROLINA'S WATERWAYS



Remain in the Surveyor Gener's office uncertified till the Petitioner produce the rest of his Family in this province. Charles Town, the 2d day of Jan'y 1753 Jacob Duckett. The prayer thereof was granted provided the Petit'rs Famil come to settle in a 12 month from the Present date.

[Meeting of Thursday A. M. 2d January 1753]

→ Pages 147-148: The Petition of Samuel Chapman humbly setting forth That the Petitioner is Lately come into this Province and desires to settle with hi Family on the waters of Broad River and having a Wife and four children and never having had for them any grant of land, prays to run out 300 acres o Land on the waters of Broad River as aforesaid, and that he may have a Grant for the same. Cha's Town, the 2d day of Jan'y 1753. Samuel Chapman The prayer thereof was granted.

Page 148: The Petition of Robert Burton humbly setting forth That the Petitioner is desirous of settling a Plantation on the waters of Pedee River and to Cultivate and Improve some of his Majestys vacant Land there viz 50 acres of Land in his own right, prays to run out 50 acres of Land as aforesaid Cha's Town, the 2d day of Jan'y 1753. Robert Burton. The prayer thereof was granted.

Pages 148-149: The Petition of James Edie humbly setting forth That the Petitioner is desirous of settling on the waters of Lynches Creek and having a wife and two children for whom nor yet for himself has any land beer assigned him, prays to run out 200 acres of Land on the waters of Lynches Creek as aforesaid. Cha's Town, the 2d day of Jan'y 1753. James Edie. The prayer thereof was granted.

Page 149: The Petition of William Harvey humbly setting forth That the Petitioner finding some vacant land in Prince Williams parish which he is desirous of Cultivating and having Seventeen negroes by virtue of which Family right not any land been assigned him in this province, prays to run out 850 acres of Land as aforesaid. Cha's Town, the 4th day of Jan'y 1753 William Harvey. The prayer thereof was granted.

The Petition of John Gungle humbly setting forth That the Petitioner has settled himself Conveniently in the Fork of Broad and Saludy Rivers, and having a wife and four children for whom nor yet for himself has any land been assigned, prays to run out 300 acres of Land in the Forks as aforesaid. Cha's Town, the 1st day of Jan'y 1753. John Jungle. The prayer thereof was granted.

Pages 149-150: The Petition of James Cooper humbly shewing That in the month of Nov'r was a twelve month the Petit'r obtained a Warr't for 100 acres of land on Lynches Creek which upon surveying appeared to be wholly surrounded by Land granted to Mr. Baxter so that the said Tract designed for
