

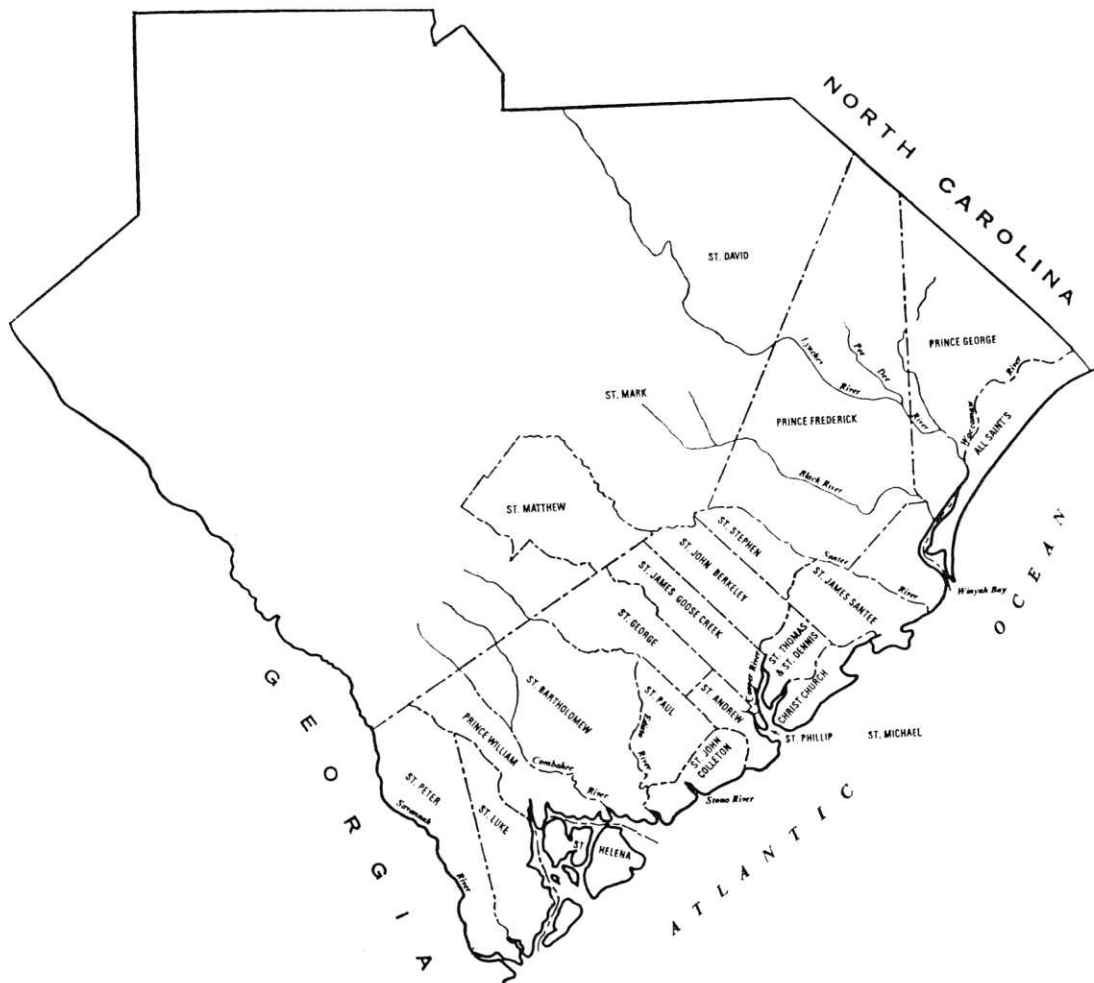

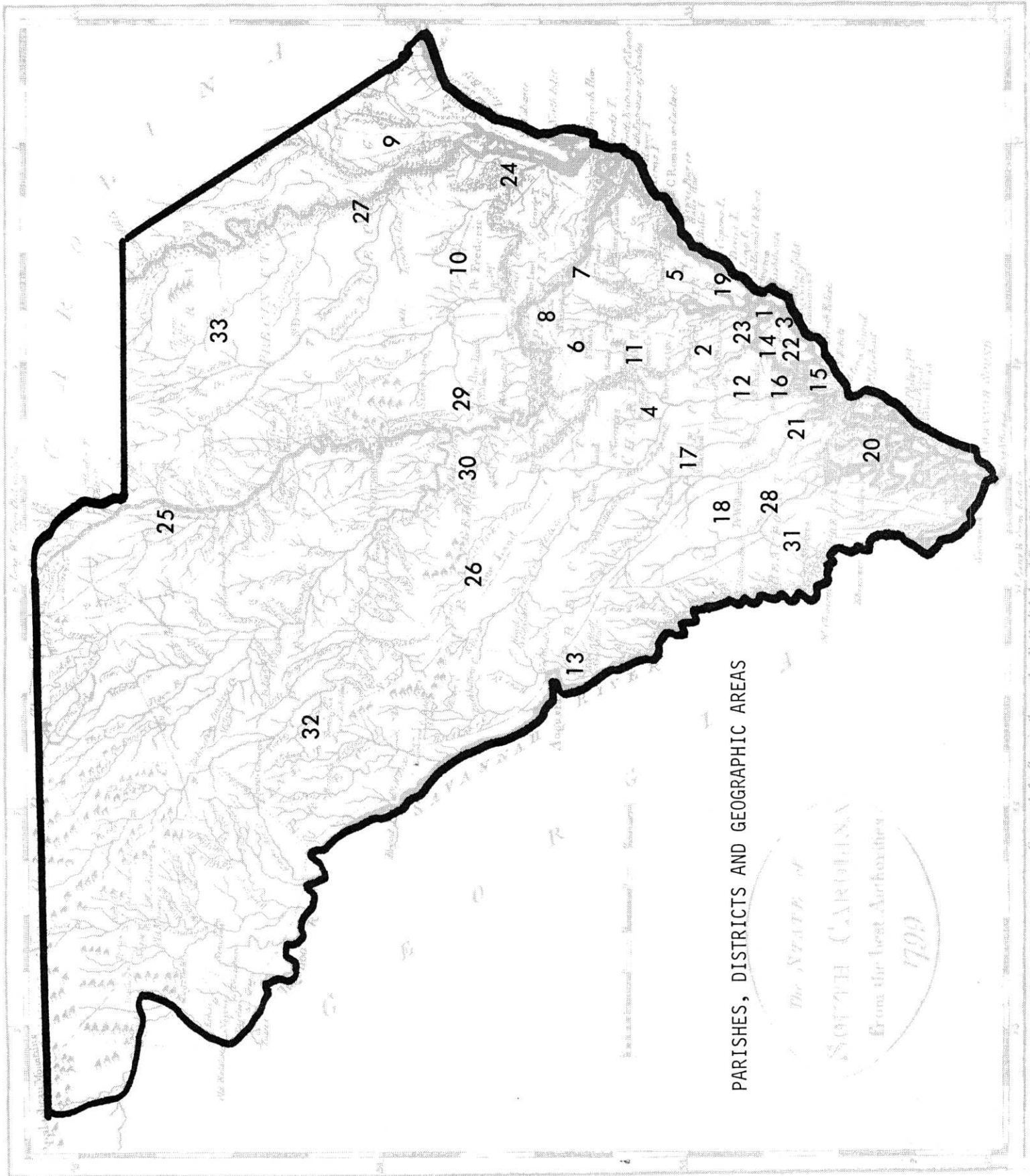

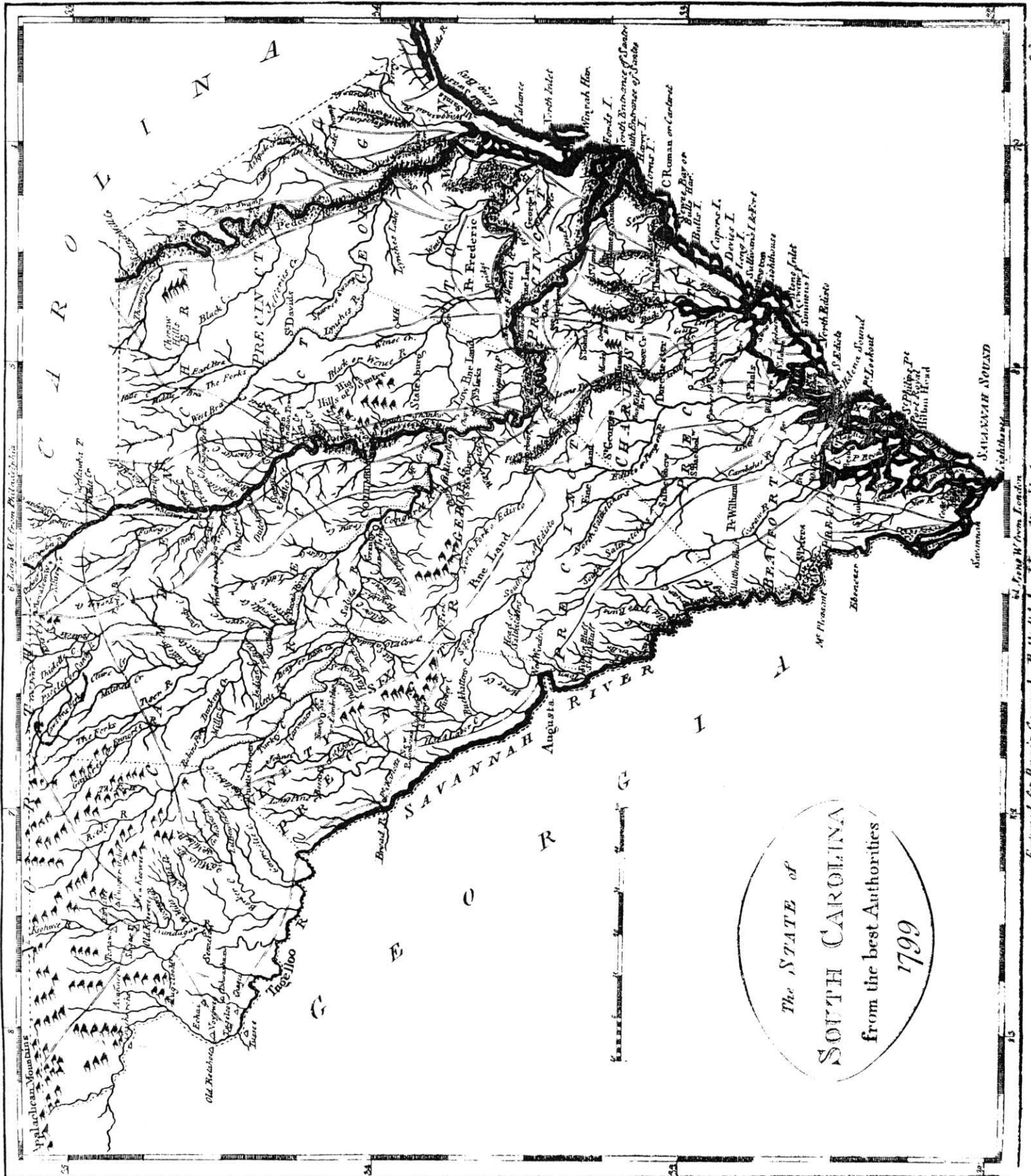

THE PARISHES

- 1 ST. PHILIP'S PARISH, Berkeley County, established 1706. Charles Town and Charles Town Neck.
- 19 CHRIST CHURCH PARISH, Berkeley County, established 1706. Southeast of Wando River, along the coast east of Charles Town.
- 5 ST. THOMAS' PARISH, Berkeley County, established 1706. Above Christ Church Parish, on north-east of Wando River.
- 5 ST. DENNIS' PARISH, established 1706. Created for the French settlement, adjoined and merged with St. Thomas' to form ST. THOMAS AND ST. DENNIS PARISH.
- 6 ST. JOHN'S PARISH, Berkeley County, established 1706. The western branch of Cooper River.
- 11 ST. JAMES, GOOSE CREEK, Berkeley County, established 1706. On Goose Creek.
- 2 ST. ANDREWS' PARISH, Berkeley County, established 1706. On the Ashley River.
- 12 ST. PAUL'S PARISH, Colleton County, established 1706. On south side of Stono River, extending to the north side of the South Edisto River.
- 17 ST. BARTHOLOMEW'S PARISH, Colleton County, established 1706. North of St. Helena's Parish.
- 7 ST. JAMES, SANTEE, the French settlement on Santee River, established 1706.
- 20 ST. HELENA'S PARISH, Granville County, established 1712. Bounded by St. Helena's Sound, Savannah River, Combahee River, and the ocean.
- 4 ST. GEORGE'S PARISH, DORCHESTER, Berkeley County, established 1717. The upper part of St. Andrew's Parish on Ashley River.
- 9 PRINCE GEORGE'S PARISH, WINYAW, Craven County, established in 1721. On the coast between Santee and Peedee Rivers, extending westward as far as inhabited.
- 22 ST. JOHN'S PARISH, COLLETON County, established 1734. Formed from St. Paul's Parish. John's Island, Wadmalaw Island, Edisto Island, and the other adjacent islands.
- 10 PRINCE FREDERICK'S PARISH, WINYAW, Craven County, established in 1734. Formed from Prince George's Parish. The upper section between Santee and Peedee Rivers.
- 18 PRINCE WILLIAM'S PARISH, Granville County, established 1745. Formed from St. Helena's Parish. The upper or inland section along Combahee and Coosawhatchie Rivers.
- 31 ST. PETER'S PARISH, Granville County, established 1746. Formed from St. Helena's Parish. Included the township of Purrysburgh and adjacent lands along the Savannah River.
- 1 ST. MICHAEL'S PARISH, Charles Town, established 1751. Taken from St. Philip's Parish.
- 8 ST. STEPHEN'S PARISH, established 1754. Formed from St. James' Parish, Santee. The inland or upper section.
- 29 ST. MARK'S PARISH, established 1757. Formed from Prince Frederick's Parish. Between Santee and Peedee Rivers, above the lower Williamsburgh Township line, and inland.
- ST. LUKE'S PARISH, established 1767. Formed from St. Helena's Parish, joining St. Peter's Parish; the Euhaws. Disallowed by the King in 1770 and abolished as a parish.
- ALL SAINTS' PARISH, established 1767, Georgetown District, along Waccamaw River. Disallowed by the King in 1770 and abolished as a parish. Recreated by the Assembly in 1778.
- 30 ST. MATTHEW'S PARISH, Orangeburgh Township, Berkeley County, established 1768. Along the Edisto River.
- ST. DAVID'S PARISH, established 1768. Formed from St. Mark's and Prince Frederick's Parishes. The inland, upper section between the headwaters of Lynch's River and Peedee River.
- ORANGE PARISH, Orangeburgh District, established 1778. Formed from St. Matthew's Parish.

HOW THE JURY LISTS ARE PUBLISHED

To make it possible to present the names and the locations in the least space, numbers have been assigned to both the names of the parish, district or county of residence, and to the type of jury list on which the name appeared.

YEAR CO J NAME [index headings]

YEAR is the year in which the citizen qualified as a juror

CO is the parish, district or county in which the juror RESIDED; table below.

J is the type of jury on which the citizen was qualified to serve:

- "1" GRAND JUROR
- "2" PETIT JUROR
- "3" SPECIAL JUROR

NAME is that of the juror, last name first, then given name, followed by any remarks included in the list.

PARISHES, DISTRICTS AND GEOGRAPHIC AREAS FOUND IN JURY LISTS

The original lists were recorded in parishes, districts, counties or geographic areas, and all jurymen residing in that particular region were listed in random alphabetic order. To facilitate transcription, yet provide these locations, the names of parishes, districts, counties or areas have been replaced in the index by the following numerical codes published under CO heading:
