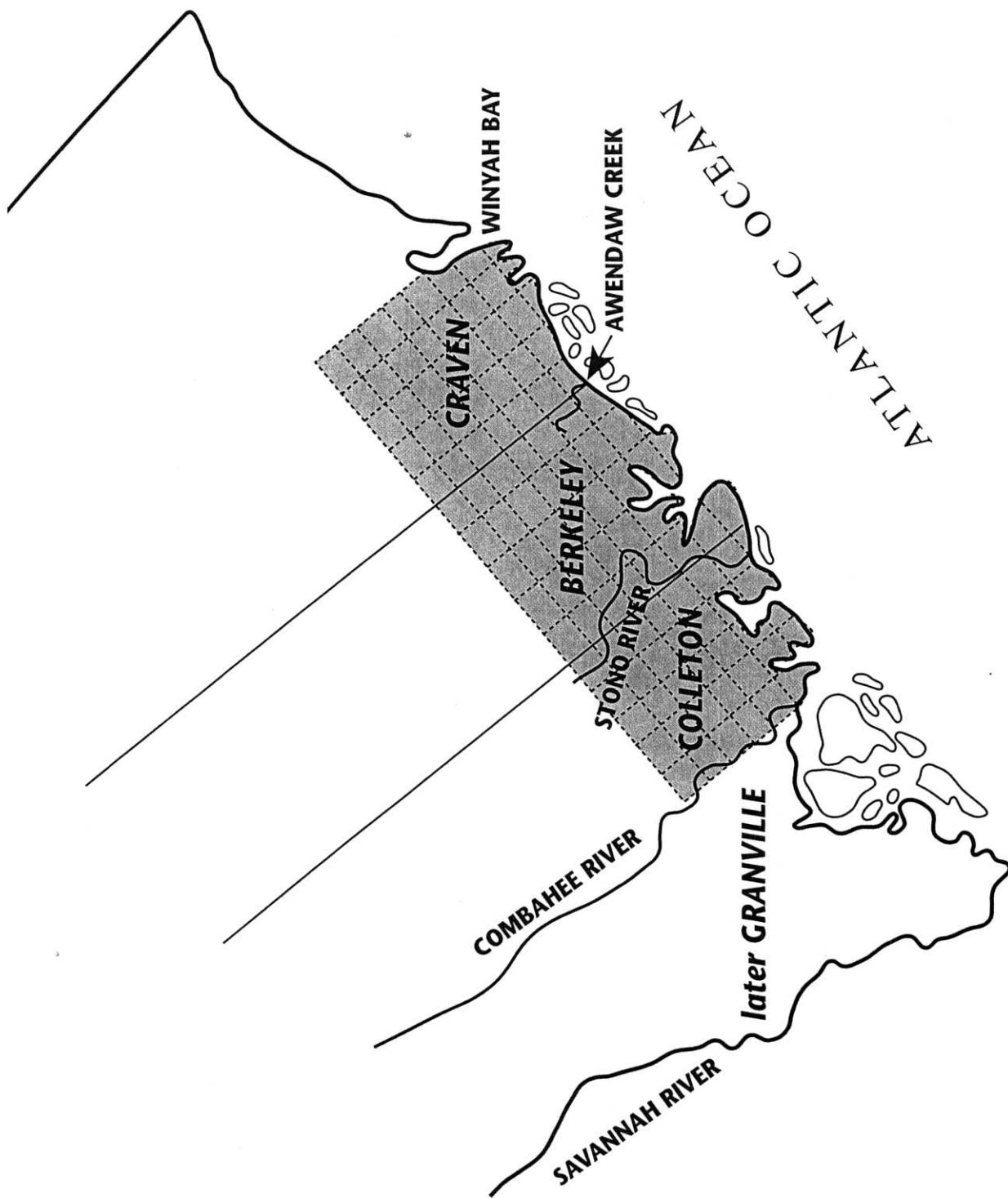

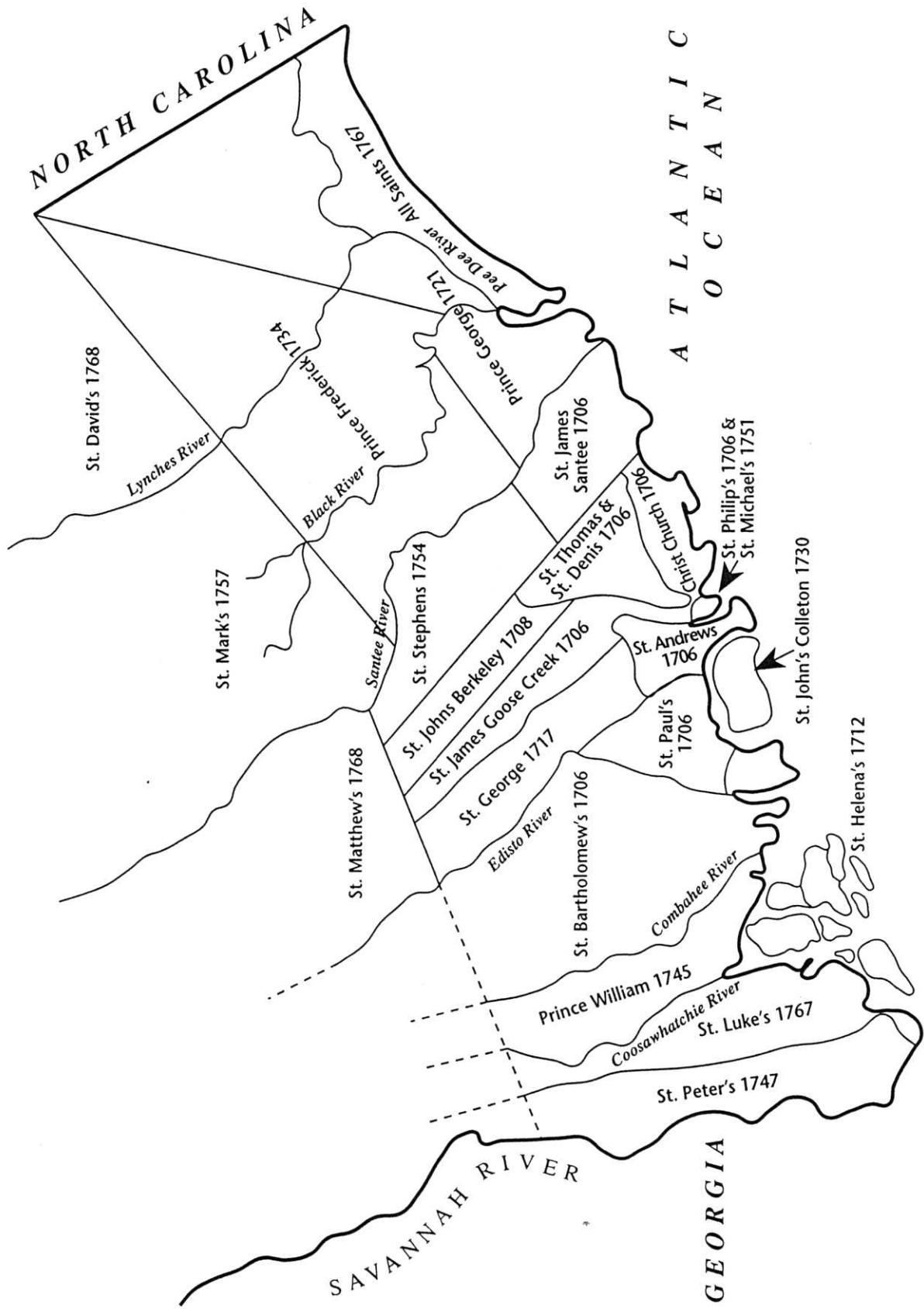

1, 359: Florence Mahony, 100 acres on west side Pon Pon River adj. said Mahony, Coll: Bull, Sullivan, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 20 June 1733.

1, 360: George Pawley, Esqr., 500 acres in Craven County on Wacomaw River adj. John Thompson, on a navigable thorowfare to Pedee, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 19 Dec 1732.

1, 361: Mr. Philip Combe, 500 acres in Craven County, 22 May 1734. Plat certified 6 April 1733.

1, 362: Mr. Benjamin Pederan, 200 acres in Craven County adj. James Savony, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 1 March 1732.

1, 363: Mr. Thomas Potts, 430 acres in Craven County adj. John Horry, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 11 Jan 1732/3.

1, 364: Royall Spry, 575 acres in Colleton County adj. Thomas Sacheverall, said Royall Spry, John Williamson, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 7 Feb 1732.

1, 365: Royall Spry, 185 acres in Colleton County adj. William Nash, James Bullock, Captain John Bull, Thomas Sacheveral, Bryan Bailey, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 8 Feb 1732.

1, 366: Thomas Brown, 150 acres in Craven County on Santee River, 23 May 1734. Plat certified 19 Feb 1733.

1, 367: Zachariah Villepontos, 52 acres in Berkley County on south side of Ashley River, on the north side of James Island, adj. Wm. Chapman, 23 Nov 1734. ←

1, 368: Mr. John Page, 900 acres in Colleton County on east side of Cuckhold's Neck adj. William Cockram, said Page, ont the dividing branch of Bryan and Wannells Creek, 5 April 1733.

1, 369: Mr. John Viccaridge, 500 acres in Craven County adj. Edward Thomas, Elias Ball, James Sinclair, 17 May 1734. Plat certified 7 Dec 1732.

1, 370: Captain Tobias Fitch, 1540 acres in Berkley County on west side of a Cyprus Swamp made by the head of Ashly River, 22 April 1735. Plat certified 4 Jan 1731.

1, 371: Captn Tobias Fitch, 1783 acres in Berkley County on a Cypruss Swamp made by a branch of Edisto River called four hole creek, 22 April 1735. Plat certified 11 June 1733.

1, 372: James Akins, 500 acres in Craven County on south side of Waccamaw River, 23 April 1735. Plat certified 19 Aug 1734.

1, 618: William Carwithen, 450 acres in Colleton County adj. Alexander McLroy, William Perriman, on Edisto River, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 18 June 1735.

1, 619: Peter Allston, 300 acres adj. Coll: Waties, on Peedee River adj. John Allston, 6 Aug 1735. Plat certified 5 Jan 1733.

→ 1, 620: John Fendin, 154 acres in Granville County adj. Judith Rose, William Chapman, William Adams, Benjamin Cowen, Joseph Scott, John Cowen, John Johnson, Paul Grimbball, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 10 June 1734.

1, 621: George Lea, 650 acres in Craven County adj. Mr. Borland, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 13 June 1734.

1, 622: Nathaniel Snow, 2000 acres in Craven County adj. William Snow, Widow Bampfield, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 30 March 1734.

1, 623: Abraham Warnock, 45 acres in Craven County on Waccamaw River, it being an Island included thereby, 8 Aug 1735. Plat certified 1 Feb 1733.

1, 624: Thomas Farr, 638 acres in Colleton County adj. Joseph Blake, Christopher Wilkinson, William Farr, Edmond Bellinger, 6 Aug 1735. Plat certified 18 Feb 1734.

1, 625: John Phipps, 600 acres in Craven County on Santee River Swamp adj. Mr. Williams, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 1 Jan 1734.

1, 626: James Baxter, 400 acres in Craven County on the north branch of Little River adj. Jonathan Calking, 6 Aug 1735. Plat certified 25 June 1734.

1, 627: Abraham Michaux, 820 acres in Craven County adj. Jonathan Christmas, William Newman, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 12 March 1732.

1, 628: James Stewart, 800 acres in Craven County adj. said Stewart, John Musgrave, on George Town River and Turkey Creek, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 23 March 1732/3.

1, 629: Thomas Powell, 200 acres in Craven County, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 6 Nov 1734.

1, 630: Nathaniel Snow, 400 acres in Craven County adj. William Snow, 7 Aug 1735. Plat certified 24 Dec 1734.

1, 631: David Fulton, 250 acres in Craven County adj. Mr. Shipy, on the northwest branch of Black River, adj. James Futhy, 6 Aug 1735. Plat certified 5 Feb 1731/2.

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3, 42: John McCaw, 200 acres in Colleton County adj. Mr. Macheau, John Cook, 12 Aug 1737. Plat certified 23 Dec 1736.

3, 43: Hugh Campbell, 270 acres in Colleton County on the Swamp of Saltcatcher River adj. said Campbell, 12 Aug 1737. Plat certified 12 April 1737.

3, 44: Hugh Campbell, 300 acres in Craven County River adj. Mr. Wastcoat, Benjamin Stiles, 12 Aug 1737. Plat certified 28 July 1734.

3, 45: James Coachman, 400 acres in Berkley County, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 11 Jan 1736/7.

3, 46: William Arnold, 500 acres in Craven County adj. Thomas Brown, Robert Rivers, on the long bay, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 28 Jan 1734/5.

→ 3, 47: Thomas Elliott, son of Willm Elliott, 580 acres in Colleton County adj. William Chapman, on Pon Pon River, near the north mouth of Musketer Creek that leads from Pon Pon River to Bennets point on Ashepoo River, 13 July 1737. Plat certified & Dec 1736.

3, 48: Mrs. Phebe Peters, 1400 acres in Craven County on Santee River adj. Joseph Childs on the Great Savannah no the north side of Santee River, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 28 Sept 1736.

3, 49: Capt. William Pinckney, 564 acres in Colleton County adj. George Atwood, William Ebberson, James Stanyard, John Woodward, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 8 Feb 1736/7.

3, 50: Mrs. Catharine Ioor, 450 acres in Craven County on the north side of Waccamaw River in Prince Georges Parish, adj. Michael Jean, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 25 Nov 1736.

3, 51: Samuel Jackson, 200 acres in Craven County on the north side of the west branch of Little River adj. Samuel Masters, 12 Aug 1737. Plat certified 5 March 1734.

3, 52: Barnard Elliott, 600 land and marsh acres in Colleton County adj. Thomas Elliott, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 9 Dec 1736.

3, 53: Jordan Roche, 1000 acres in Craven County adj. Anthony Atkinson Esqr., Mrs. Elizabeth Bremar, on Little Pedee River, 13 July 1737. Plat certified 19 Nov 1736.

3, 54: Daniel Crawford, 776 acres in Granville County adj. William Coachman, on the north east branch of Savannah River, 13 July 1737. Plat certified (Nov 1733.

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
