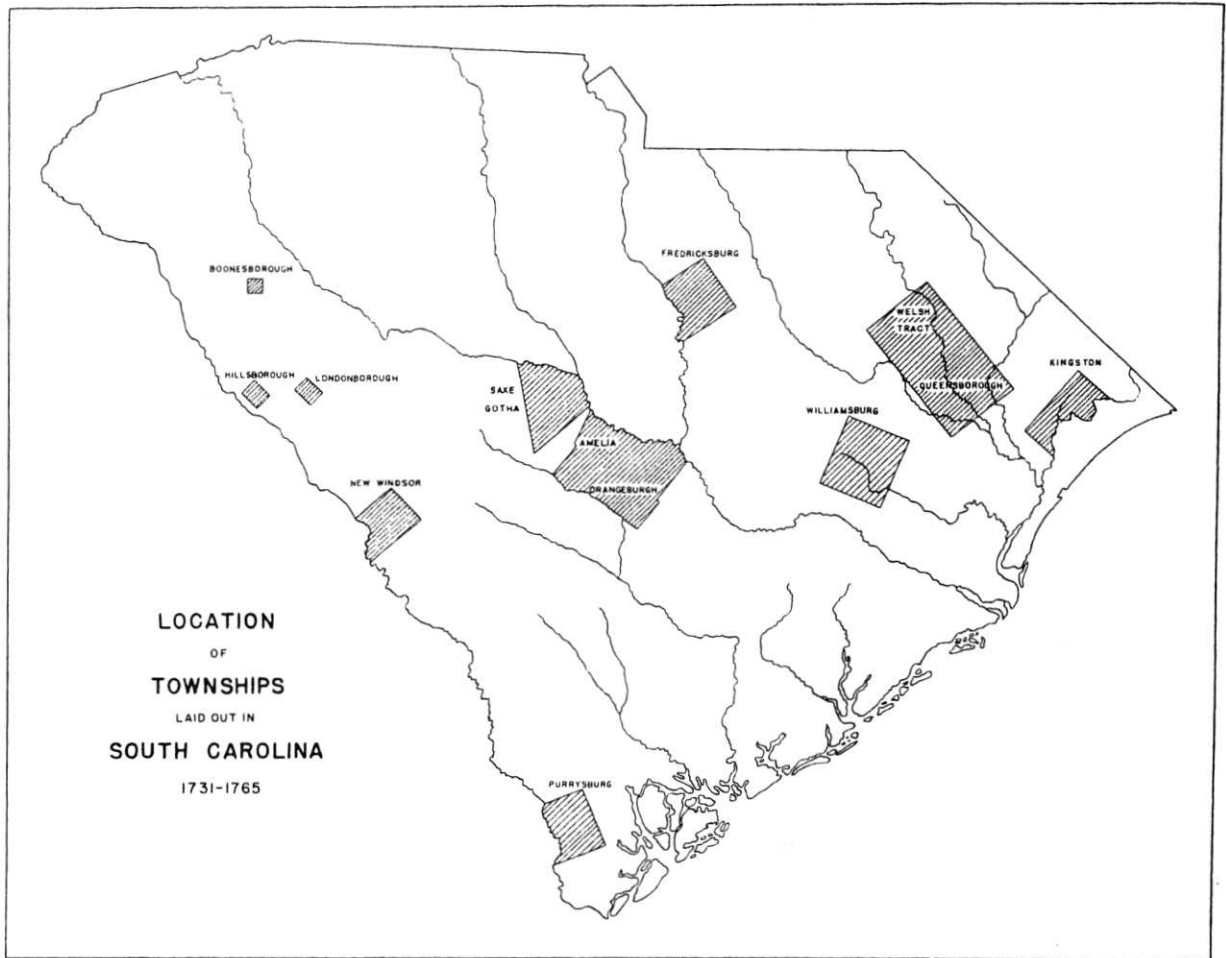

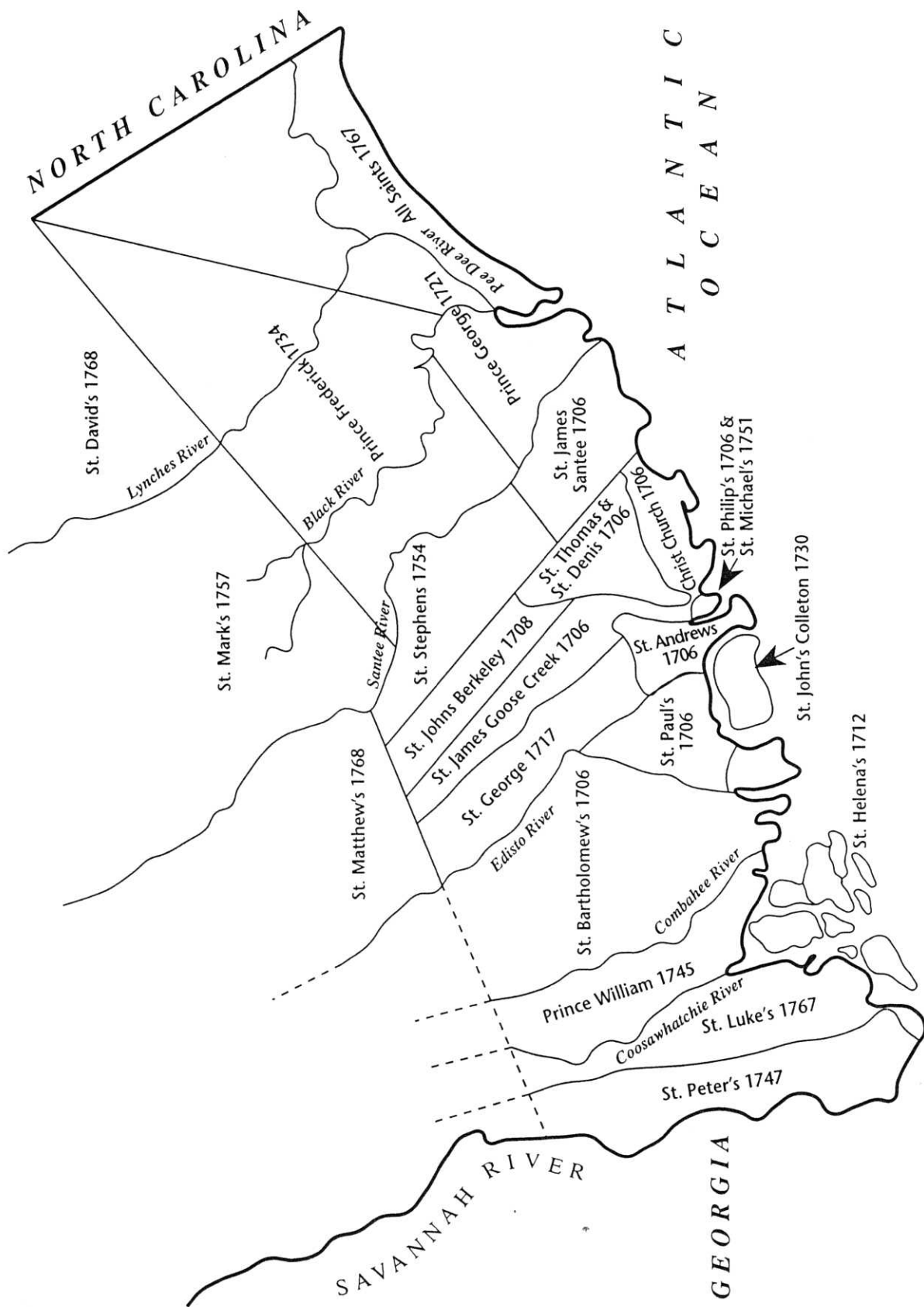

10, 1: Henry Hunter, 300 acres on the north side of Santee River in Craven County adj. James McKelvey Junr, 19 Nov 1760. Plat certified 3 Aug 1758.

10, 2: Edward Baker, 300 acres on the south west side of Little Peedee on Cypress Creek in Craven County, 19 Nov 1760. Plat certified 6 June 1759.

→ 10, 3: Samuel Chapman, 300 acres on a branch of Broad River called Little River, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 26 March 1753.

10, 4: Charles Quell, 100 acres in Craven County in the Pine Woods near Cheves Pond, 31 March 1761. Plat certified 14 Feb 1761.

10, 5: Francis Yonge, 254 acres adj. lands of said Yonge lately purchased of Mr. Blake in St. Pauls Parish, Colleton County adj. Thomas Farr, 5 May 1761. Plat certified 31 March 1761.

10, 6: John Hay, 250 acres (surveyed 18 Dec 1759 for Tacitus Guillard) in St. John Parish Berkley County adj. said Tacitus Guillard, John Pearce, William McNicholl, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 5 Dec 1760.

10, 7: William Hilliard, 100 acres surveyed the 4th day of Feb 1757 for William Hollyman on the south side of Wateree River adj. land surveyed for George Morris, land owned by Abraham Odam, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 4 Nov 1760.

10, 8: William Hilliard, 200 on the south east side of Wateree River, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 4 Nov 1760.

10, 9: Ezekiel Harlan, 100 acres in Granville County on a creek known by the name of Turkey Creek, being the waters of Stephens Creek and Savannah River (surveyed 31 March 1757 for the said Ezekiel Harlan), 31 March 1761. Plat certified 1 July 1760.

10, 10: William Dubney Coffin, 350 acres on Savannah River between the lands of Edward Mayham and an improvement made by John Wood including the Iron mine spring, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 4 Nov 1760.

10, 11: Thomas Potts, 250 acres on Santee on Potatoe Creek, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 6 Nov 1759.

10, 12: James Delaney, 100 acres in Craven County in the Forks between Drowning Creek and little Peedee surveyed 26th March 1758 for Alexander Campbell, 31 March 1761. Plat certified 4 June 1760.

10, 13: George Heiks, 200 acres on the north side of Peedee River in the Welch Tract, 16 Jan 1761. Plat certified 16 April 1752.

12, 329: James Tweed, 820 acres on Savannah River near Parachucula Bluff, Granville County, adj. Drury Dunn, Hugh Kenedy, John Smith, 3 June 1765. Plat certified 11 March 1765.

12, 330: James Cheek, 550 acres on Beaver Dam Branch, the north east side of Saluda River, Berkley County, 3 June 1765. Plat certified 5 Jan 1765.

12, 331: John Marley, 1000 acres in the fork of Saluda and Broad Rivers adj. Samuel Rooker, Gasper Fouts, Barbara Rome, Jacob Berkland, Barbara Bome, John Friday, Gasper Mathias, 3 June 1765. Plat certified 5 Feb 1765.

12, 332: Daniel Cannon, 1000 acres on the south west side of Saluda River adj. John Rister, John Bear, George Threft, Marlin Harler, Mary Rough, 3 June 1765. Plat certified 30 Jan 1765.

12, 333: George Golphin, 1495 acres in New Winsor Township on Savannah River in Granville County adj. Ulrick Tobler, Zachariah Lemar, Robert Lemar, Gosper Strouble, on Town Creek and Savannah River, which said tract was formerly surveyed for Mr. Julk, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 25 March 1765.

12, 334: Thomas Middleton, Esquire, 50 acres on Port Royal Island, on a branch of Beaufort River, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 3 June 1765.

12, 335: John McWilliams, 100 acres in Berkley County adj. David Webb, on Santee River, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 14 Jan 1765.

12, 336: Charles Partin, 100 acres on a branch of Little Saluda called Nine Creek adj. Drury's Fort, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 2 April 1765.

12, 337: William Hendricks, 150 acres (surveyed 22 Jan 1763 for John Lindsay) on James Creek, Berkley County, 21 June 1765. [plat date not included]

12, 338: Jonathan Davies, 150 acres on Wadmelow Island adj. Thomas Hext, Robert Turner Senior, Henry Livingston, 24 Nov 1764. Plat certified 7 Nov 1764.

12, 339: Thomas Lewis, 100 acres on Scotch Creek, Craven County adj. Giles Chapman, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 23 Nov 1764. ←

12, 340: John Wheeler, 200 acres in Craven County, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 6 Nov 1764.

12, 341: Melchior Leightensteiger, 150 acres in Purrysburgh Township adj. Henery Bourquin, Jacob Winglar, Daniel Brabant, 21 June 1765. Plat certified 19 Nov 1764.

14, 77: William Byrd, 200 acres in Craven County on the Black Swamp near Lynch Creek, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 13 Nov 1766.

14, 78: Richard Baldrick, 50 acres in St. Mathews Parish near Santee River, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 13 Oct 1766.

14, 79: Daniel Cannon, 500 acres in Colleton County adj. Moses Kirkland, John Marlow, on a small river not navigable, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 8 Sept 1766.

14, 80: Absolom Best, 200 acres in Catfish, a branch of Peedee, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 2 Sept 1766.

14, 81: Oliver Cromwell, 400 acres on the north side of Congaree River adj. Hooker's old friend in Craven County on the said river, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 3 Dec 1766.

14, 82: Jacob Credick, 100 acres in Craven County on Cedar Creek, a branch of Broad River, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 3 Dec 1766.

14, 83: Benjamin Farrar, 300 acres, Craven County adj. William Walling, on Santee River, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 4 Nov 1766.

14, 84: Benjamin Farrar, 300 acres in Granville County adj. William Davis, heirs of ___ Jackson, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 10 June 1766.



14, 85: Giles Chapman, 300 acres in Berkley County adj. Terence Riley, John Brooks, John Wilkinson, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 4 Nov 1766.

14, 86: Stephen Creech, 200 acres in Berkley County, 16 Dec 1766. [plat date not included]

14, 87: William Farlow, 200 acres in Berkley County adj. Eliza Jones, Patrick Ryley, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 14 June 1766.

14, 88: Thomas Ferguson, 1000 acres in Colleton County adj. Mr. Jackson, on a swamp, 16 Dec 1766. Plat certified 6 Sept 1766.

14, 333: Andrew Egar, 150 acres in Granville county adj. James Hamilton, Adam Alexander, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 14 Aug 1766.

14, 334: Silas Harrington, 150 acres on the north side of Great Peedee on Crooked Creek, Craven County, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 24 Jan 1767.

14, 335: John Furnass, 150 acres on Gilders Creek, Craven County adj. Charles King, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 4 Nov 1767.

14, 341: William Lucas, 150 acres on Black Creek, Craven County, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 3 March 1767.

14, 342: Patrick Smith, 100 acres on Little River in Craven County adj. Samuel Chapman, Daniel Reece, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 2 Sept 1766.

14, 343: William Thompson, 500 acres in Berkley County adj. John Perdreau, estates ___ Glaze, ___ Holmes, and White, and Hon. Daniel Blake Esqr., 7 May 1767. Plat certified 11 Feb 1767.

14, 344: Daniel Stewart, 1000 acres in Berkley County & St. Georges Parish Dorchester adj. John Perdreau, 7 May 1767. Plat certified 4 March 1767.
