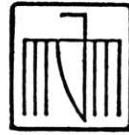

Samuell Goodman: Hugh Carmicaell: George Smart Allen Knight Arthur Rooke: Richard Grible: Jn^o: Ardning: Thomas Browne: William Chapman: Christopher: Sympson: Joanna Agrees: The names of all which persons were Registred in the Secretaries office. within y^e space of fourteen dayes. after their Respective arraivell in the Province aforesaid, You are therefore to Survey and Admeasure out for the said Benjamin Waring seven hundred Acres of Land according to the Rules and Proportions apoynted by the Lords Prop^rs Instructions for Granting of Land, Bearing Date y^e 6th: day of ffeb^r: 1692: of which Survey you are to make Certifycate, the which Together with the plott of said Land, you are to returne to me, that Grants may be made for the s^d Land, and you are to take notice that if the said Benjamin Waring doth nott within the space of ninety dayes after your Surveying and admeasureing out the said seven hundred Acres of Land take out Grants for the same. & Signe the Counterpart thereof according as it is apoynted by the power to me Given & Granted by William Earle of Craven

Whereby your Petiti^or hath lost y^e benefitt of the s^d office of Sec^ry dureing y^e s^d i8 Moneths to his damage of 400^l

Your Pet^r: Therefore Humbly prays that your Honor^s will please to Grant him your Warr^t, Comanding y^e s^d Seth Sothell to appeare before your Honor^s: & answeare y^e s^d complaint at a day Certaine. Henry Colls William Pople & Edward Loughton Did on the first of febr^{ry} i690. being Sabbath day after sun sett. came to y^e house of Mr. Edward Rawlins the Marshall in Charles Towne entered y^e Chamber of yo^r Pet^r: there and did forceably open yo^r. Pet^r: box rifled his goods and did carry away a Letter case full of papers & Letters of his

private concernes to seth Sothell Esq^r, we^h did in y^e presence of Cap^{tt}. Quarry M^r Izard & others in S^d Sothells. chamber examine y^e s^d papers and did then and to this day doth keepe part of them from your said Pet^r:/

And farther that y^e same night y^e said Mullins Pople & ct, Entered y^e house of M^r. Nicholas Tounsend in Charles Towne where your Pet^r: had a box with Merchandize goods y^e which box y^e s^d Mullins & Pople broke open and rifled. butt whether any of said goods were Carried away yo^r. Pet^r: doth not know he being a Close prisoner at y^e same time/

→ And likewise Sheweth-that y^e S^d Sothell in great hast Sent M^r William Chapman constable of Charles Towne with Seaven other men out of Berkley County into Colleton County to your Pet^rs: house on Edistoh Island we^h. is about 40 miles by water from Charles Towne Whoe came to your Pet^rs. said house on tuesday the 3^d of febr^y. i69i: befor day entered y^e s^d house with Clubbs in their hands to y^e Great consternation of your Pet^rs wife children and family they not knowing at first whoe they were or what they came about and then and there did search your Pet^rs: house upon pretense for publick papers & Records.

From whence they went to the house of M^r. John Hamilton your Pet^rs: Sonn in Law, which was about a mile from your Pet^rs: house and there Searched under the pretence aforsaid/

Your Pet^r likewise Sheweth that there were Severall Letters and orders sent to yo^r Pet^r: from the Pallatine and the Ld^s. Prop^rs: by Cap^{tt}. Dodson Impowering yo^r. Pet^r: to receive their Lord^{pps}: Rents as Directed as also to Sell 6000 Acres of Land to the Inhabitants of Carolina according to Instructions, with other privatt Letters from y^e Hono^{ble} Sr.-Peter Colleton and others, Butt the said Seth Sothell not regarding of y^e Honor and Service of their Lord^{pps} nor y^e good of y^e Inhabitants of Carolina, on or about the 27th of febr^y i690 at Charles Towne in an illegal & arbitrary maner Did Seize y^e Ld^s: orders & Letters as afforsaid Did & doth Refuse to deliver them to your Pet^r: though often desired in contempt of the Lords and their Authority and the great prejudice of y^e people And as your Pet^r did heare y^e S^d Sothell did breake open y^e aforsaid orders & Letters/

And for as much as all which was done by the s^d Seth Sothell his orders & Comands yo^r. Pet^r. therefore Humbly prays that your Hono^{rs}: may please to Sumons y^e s^d Seth Sothell to appeare befor this Hono^{ble} Court to answeare y^e premises as likewise to

deliver to yo^r. Pet^r: all y^e Letters orders and papers aforesaid
 And that these proceedings may be fully & duely Represented to
 y^e Rt Hono^{ble} y^e Pallatine & Lds Prop^{rs}: to the end y^e s^d Seth
 Sothell may be by them proceeded against for such oppressions
 arbitrary & illegall practises as to their Lord^{pps}= shall Seeme
 meet & as to Law & Justice doth appertaine/
