

estate records. John W. Spiers, Franklin Co. Miss., gives power of atty. to Pliny Sheffield. 25 Feb. 1832, to receive and collect the share of said children for whom he was Guardian at the time (Deed Book "C", p. 177, Wayne Co.). Bryant Sheffield, a son of West Sheffield, R. S., moved to Hamilton Co. Fla., and also his sister, Flora, who married William Akins.

Laurens Co. Ga., deed book "C", p. 48: Deed dated 30 Mar. 1813, from Wright Sheffield, Bryant Sheffield, West Sheffield, and Arthur Sheffield, all of them identified as being "late of Laurens Co., Ga", to William Grady of Laurens Co., conveying two-thirds of 293-acre-tract in Duplin Co. N. C., given them by the will of their father, John Sheffield, late of Duplin County". P. S.: Wright Sheffield later moved to Madison Co. Fla., where he died, testate.

Laurens Co. Ga., deed book "D", p. 120:

Deed from Isham Sheffield to William Grady, both of Laurens Co., dated 9 June 1815, for 48-3/4 acres in Duplin Co. N. C., "being part of a 293-acre tract willed him by John Sheffield, his father", etc. [Isham Sheffield later moved to Early Co. Ga., where he died, 1827, as shown by records there.]

Darlington Co. S. C.: W. B. Heeth and John Chappell, executors of Henry Harris, decd., to William Harris, all of Washington Co. Ga., Power of Atty. dated 3 Sept. 1810, giving William Harris authority to sue for and collect all monies and property due the decd. in South Carolina. Receipt follows from William Harris to James Russell, William Gcc, and William Garner as exrs. of William Heeth of Darlington Co., for two slaves, \$120.00 in cash, and household goods as bequeathed by William Heeth to his daughter, Sarah Harris of Georgia. Recorded, Deed Book "C", pp. 214-215.
