County and where he came from -
probably Ireland. Also his wife Hannah
probably named Lane.
- ④ Any records of any kind on Thomas
Catter (son of John above)
- ⑤ Any records of any kind on Mary Ann
McKinstry and her parents (names
unknown to me), particularly where
they came from and when they

arrived in America.

⑥ Thomas Chiselm Estate, as mentioned in your letter. I would like copies of any documents which would be pertinent.

⑦ Could you tell me what the reports, petitions, and declarations of intention referred to with regard to Thomas + James Chisam on p. 188 + 189 of the County records enclosed.

⑧ Information on James Chiselm, father of Thomas + James who arrived in Charleston, S.C. from Belfast, Ireland. on Nov. 17, 1819
their father + perhaps mother + two sisters arrived in America some time after the same Thomas + James + a son Patrick arrived with Thomas + James in 1819. Any information on

2 wills. I'll be glad to send a check for
any other documents, and for the research done,
as soon as I am advised of the amount.

Is there an Historical Society in
Chester that does genealogical research? I
would appreciate information about that.
