 beth Herbert. In 1827 he settled in  
 Winnsboro, S.C. & soon commenced the  
 study of medicine with Dr David Means,  
 a relative of Governor Means. In 1830  
 he began the practice of medicine, soon  
 after he married Miss Woodward, sister  
 of Judge J.J. Woodward of Taladega, Ala.  
 After practicing 45 yrs, he removed with  
 his son, Dr O.M. Clarke to Augusta, Ga.  
 & lived in retirement. He left 4 child-

 Co. about 1870, bought land near St And-  
 rews where he had lived a hermit's life.
