Caleb Clarke to James Elder Dated at Loris

In the State of South Carolina I Know all men by these presents that I Caleb Clarke citizen
of the Town of Winnsborough in the District of Hanfield and State aforesaid in consideration of
one thousand dollars to me paid by James Elder of the said Town, District, and State aforesaid
I do now and do hereby and by these presents do now and do hereby sell and deliver
over unto the said James Elder all that piece or lot of land containing one acre more
or less, situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid bounded on the North by
Hawthorne Street of the said Town of Winnsborough and on the east by the main road leading to
Columbia commencing at a rock marked or planted by the Commissioners of the said Town of
Winnsborough to designate the south eastern line of the said Hawthorne Street and the south
western cause of Congress Street and from thence running southerly the course of the said
south western line of the said Congress, but the distance of one half of an acre and from
thence running westerly in a straight line with the south east line of the said Hawthorne Street
until it intersects the course of the North east line of Hanfield Street and from thence to
the south east line of the said Hawthorne Street which said lot of land is hereafter to be
particularly designated by a survey and a plot thereof to be attached to this conveyance and
the description of said lot of land to be governed by said survey and plot together with all and
singular the rights, members, incidents and appurtenances to the said premises bel-
onging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said James Elder his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and Administrators by warrant and
process of law to defend and protect the said premises unto the said James Elder his heirs
and assigns against myself and my heirs and all other persons whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and

Thomas Griffin & Ann Rowe Marriage Agreement

The State of South Carolina } their Indenture hyschell made & apt in the year of our Lord
Taunfeld Durkell 3 one thousand eight hundred and forty five between Thomas Griffin of the Lirst
and State of oversaid of the one party Ann Rowe widow of the District and State of oversaid of the second
party and George Murphy son of the District and State of oversaid of the other party witnesseth. Whereas
a marriage is shortly to be had and solemnized between the said Thomas Griffin and the said
Ann Rowe, and whereas it is agreed by and between the said Thomas and the said wife that
the property of the said Ann shall not nor shall any part thereof real or personal, monies
lands notes or other choses in action be ever subject or liable to the debts, contracts or
incumbrances of the said Thomas by the said intended marriage, but that the same shall continue
for the sole use benefit and behoof of the said wife, and subject to her control direction and
disposal, the said marriage to the contrary notwithstanding. Now therefore their Indenture
Witnesseth that the said Ann doth in consideration of the aforesaid agreement and of
the said intended marriage doth grant bargaine and sell aforesaid released transferred set
over and delivered, and by these presents doth grant bargaine and sell aforesaid release transfer
set over and deliver unto the said George Murphy his heirs executors administrators brokers and
agents all his interest in both plantation or tract of land situated in the District and State
aforesaid containing one hundred and nine acres bounded by lands of John H Dowdell
Robert Colthart John Wiley and others, and also all her household and kitchen furniture
one mare and colt, two cows and calves, ten head hogs, one boar and three bids and
furniture to have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land and all the the aforesaid goods
chattels and effects and choses in action unto the said George Murphy his heirs executors
