She was a member of St. Matthews Baptist Church #2.

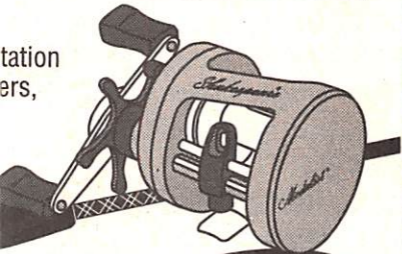
