

Glenn, m. 1-24-1782. Joseph Coleman (8), son of Daniel Coleman III (7) and Patience Thompson Coleman. Around 1784, Sytha and Joseph Coleman moved from Cumberland Co., Va., to S. C. Joseph Coleman d. ca. 1806 (Will, Box 4, pkg. 45, Union Co., S. C.). Sytha Glenn Coleman m. 2nd in 1820 John Bowles (brother of Elizabeth Bowles who m. James Glenn (332)). (Sytha and John Bowles signed a marriage contract which is filed in a Deed Bk. in the Office of the Clerk of Court of Union Co., S. C. They had no children. John Bowles d. 1836 and Sytha d. 7-17-1844 at the home of her soft-in-law Benjamin Ellis. (See Pension Record of Joseph Coleman, W-9738).
