


Juliana MARJORIBANKS 1804-1871 (wife of Col. Joseph Ragsdale COLEMAN) Ambrotype ca. 1860



Broom's descendants and in the book "The Robert Coleman Family" by J.P. Coleman & in other sources, in order to make the captions for these pictures. The part of the said chart which I used here was taken from Dr. Broom's father's Bible and the part of the said book which I used here was taken from Cicely Coleman's father's Bible.

On Dec. 12, 1977 I, Jas.W.Green,III, was at W.F.Broom,Jr.'s (my paternal uncle's) home on Sullivan's Island and photographed these 12 cased daguerrectypes & ambrotypes. I made 50 exposures of these 12 cased photos on parts of 3 rolls of film which I call rolls 60,61,& 62. The film was 20 exposure rolls of Panatomic X 35mm film. The pictures on these two pages are from roll 61, frames 9 thru 20. The 1st exposures were of the inside of the open cases, followed by the outside of the open cases. The next exposures are shown here, being of only the picture half of the inside of the open cases. Then the last exposures were closer up shots of their faces.signed 16 Jan.78.



These are pictures of daguerrotypes and ambrotypes that once no doubt belonged to Thos. Furman BROOM, M.D. and his wife Cicely A. COLEMAN. They then became the pocessions of their daughter (Mrs. Lilla A. BROOM CLEMENTS) who gave them to her daughter (Mrs. Edith CLEMENTS MCNEILL). Edith gave them to her 1st cousin W.F. BROOM, Jr. of Sullivan's Island, S.C. on Dec. 12, 1977. W.F. BROOM, Jr. is also a grandson of the said Thos. Furman BROOM, M.D. & his wife Cicely A. COLEMAN.
