JOSEPH COLEMAN OF VIRGINIA AND SOUTH CAROLINA continued

Patience Coleman married first Elisha Mayfield, and must have lost him very early, as the Pension Records of Joseph state that she married a Triplett and names the Triplett children only, stating that a daughter not named married George Cooper. This ~~unnamed~~ daughter apparently was the only child by Elisha Mayfield. Patience's children were as follows:

While Joseph Coleman settled almost directly across Broad River from the Coleman's of Fairfield Co., we have no evidence that he was closely related to them, nor was it apparent that he was related to William, Robert, Christopher, Abner and Philip Coleman of the Jonesville section of Union County. Both of these Coleman families moved into Fairfield and Union Counties before the Revolution, while Joseph came in after that struggle was over. The Wrights, Crosbys, and Coopers lived across the River on the Boundary between Fairfield and Chester County. The Glens, Sims and Shelton settled along the Broad River in Union County.
