In the fall of 1846 three Cook brothers and a sister set out from DEKALB CO., GEORGIA on a long trip to the Hills of North Louisiana. They were as follows:

1. William D. Cook b ca 1820 S.C. lived in Nico, La. married Elizabeth Tubb.
2. John Cook lived in Nico, La. married Esther. \_\_\_\_\_
3. James A. Cooke and wife Nancy Tanner lived in Cooktown.
4. Nancy Cook married John W. Mitchell lived here in North Louisiana also.
5. Allen Cook married in DeKalb Co., Ga., to Mary A. Thurman and continued to live in Georgia.

( One will note that Mrs. Susanna (Malone) Stell died in DeKalb Co., Georgia and either her children or grandchildren married into the Cook Family and many moved to this section of North La., especially Lisbon La., with the Hearde. See books "THE SOUTHERN HEARD" , THE MEADOWS FAMILY, THE MCCLENDON FAMILY and others.

Tatum, Emmett Tatum, Mattie Lou Tatum and Sidney Earl Tatum of Dubach, La. Emmett Tatum gather of Bee (Tatum) Malone. The Sherards were also cousins to the Cooks in S.C. and Georgia.
