State Land Grants

1. 5 Nov. 1787 - 100 Acres situate in the District of Cheraw on Swift Creek waters of Lynches Creek bounding all sides on vacant land

2. 7 Jan. 1788 - 750 Acres situate in the District of Cheraw on Swift Creek, bounding S.E. on land laid out to Elisha McKee S.W. by Benj. Outlaw's land, N.W. by lands claimed by Joseph - shaw and land laid out to George Evans, East by Benjamin Outlaw's land and on all other sides on Vacant Land.

3. 3 August 1812 - a plantation or tract of land containing one thousand (1000) acres surveyed for him - the 5th June 1812. Situate in the District of Chesterfield on the head of Cedar Creek, waters of big Lynches Creek bounded N.E, S.E, S.W and N.W. by land surveyed for Elisha Mayis S.W. & W by land surveyed for George Evans, all other sides by vacant lands.

4. 5 Oct. 1812 - a plantation or tract of land containing nine hundred and Ten acres (910) survey for him the 17th July 1812. Situate in the Dist of Chesterfield on the head of the lower Alligator, waters of Black Creek
