### FAMILY OF COOPER

By H. P. Cooper Clemson, S. C. 1963

The name of COOPER is from the Anglo-Saxon. The family of Cooper is of ancient origin, having been prominent in Chester County, England, prior to 1377 A.D. Many of the Coopers in the Southern States are descendants of Sir John Cooper and Anne Ashley, daughter of Sir Anthony Ashley. Their son, Anthony Ashley Cooper, was born on July 22, 1621. He was the first Earl of Shaftesbury. Anthony Ashley Cooper was one of the grantees of the Province of Carolina in U.S.A. and he took an active part in its management. He was an active and controversial figure in the areas of politics and religion, being a strong supporter of Protestantism.

JAMES COOPER was born in 1661 at Stratford-on-Avon, Warwickshire, England. He was a first cousin of Judge William Cooper of New York, the father of James Fenimore Cooper the famous American author. Late in the seventeenth century JAMES COOPER, a nephew of the First Earl of Shaftesbury, Anthony Ashley Cooper, emigrated to the United States. James was presented with a large tract of land in New Jersey which he later sold and moved in 1685 to Philadelphia, where he had eight children by his wife Hester.

Successive generations of the descendants of JAMES COOPER and his wife Hester are given below. The common numbers under each heading represent brother or sister. The descendants of Thomas Cooper, the son of Benjamin Cooper, are underscored for convenience in tracing ancestry.

John Hampton Cooper (His mother, father, brothers, sisters & descendants)

According to information received from Dr. H. P. Cooper of Clemson College, John Hampton Cooper was listed as one of the seventh generation of Coopers in America. He was married in 1868 to Rachel Melvina Kelly, daughter of William Kelly and Elizabeth Nelson Kelly. He was a farmer and lived in Fairfield County.

Fairfield became a county in 1785. Previous to this time all records of land titles were made in Charleston. A few of the first settlers in Fairfield came from Charleston but the majority came from Virginia, Pennsylvania, and other northern colonies.

No county made a better show in the Confederate War. The U.S. Census of 1860 showed 1578 white males between the ages of 15 and 60 years. Best obtainable record shows Fairfield furnished 2,000 men to the Confederacy.

In 1913 twenty square miles of Fairfield County were annexed to Richland County. The population in this area, 14,269 acres, was estimated to be about 1,500.

Below are the Confederate War records of John Hampton Cooper and of this brother William James Cooper as obtained from the Confederate records in the Archives Building, Columbia, South Carolina, by Mary Cooper Nungezer.


